Last week, Perry Hall hosted its annual Christmas tournament -- dubbed the Little 20 Tournament -- over the weekend.

The tournament featured 300-plus wrestlers from around the state, including 16 teams. The host team finished a respectable fifth place with five wrestlers making the championship finals.

This year's event was a deep and talented tournament with some of Maryland's top teams participating, including schools from Howard, Anne Arundel, Carroll and Montgomery counties along with the usual local Baltimore County and City teams.

Josh Benzing won the 175-pound title going 3-0 on the day with all three wins coming by way of pin fall.

Camryn Grindle won the 116-pound championship finals, squeaking out a close decision versus a Middle River wrestler in the finals.

William Bressner won the 60-pound title and leads the team with 23 wins on the season. Silver medals were won by Tyler Klein at 100 pounds and Hunter Yoakum at 107 pounds, who both wrestled well falling to Woodlawn opponents in the finals.

Other wrestlers who fared well at the event were Patrick Sidelinger at 125 pounds who finished fifth, Nathaniel Moskunas at 82 pounds placed fourth, Kyle Zhong finished fourth at 68 pounds, Dylan Kelley placed fifth at 68 pounds, Pablo Thompson finished fifth as well at 92 pounds, as did Alec Blume at 175 pounds.
