Recognizing the need for an organization dedicated to uniting the American Irish Community, Michael McGovern and Joe Jackson founded the present American Irish Association, Inc. of Woodbridge, NJ on July 4th, 1966.

As defined in our Constitution, some of the purposes and aims of our organization are to:

- Endeavor to unite the Irish and Irish Americans of Woodbridge and the surrounding areas in a bond of friendship.
- Promote Irish culture and preserve its traditions and heritage.
- Respectfully commemorate every St. Patrick's Day.

We would like to share our Irish heritage with you. Regular membership is open to American Irish men and women, their respective spouses and their children who attain eighteen years of age. Social membership is open to other adults who are not of Irish background. After two years of good membership pass, regular membership is granted.

Our Association provides a number of annual activities in a continuing effort to bring members together in a social atmosphere. Such activities include Breakfasts, Cocktail Party, Irish Flag Raising Ceremony at Woodbridge Town Hall, St. Patrick's Day Parade, Bus Trips and other events.

General Meetings are held the second Friday of each month from September through June and the entire membership is advised of such meeting via a monthly newsletter.
