

2nd Grade Rules ~ Westfield Baseball League

I. General League Notes:

- Goals & Objectives
 - o FUN: The #1 goal should be for players to have fun & learn to love the game
 - INSTRUCTIONAL: Spring In-Town is primarily an instruction league, and players of all abilities & skill levels are welcome
 - SKILL DEVELOPMENT & FUNDAMENTALS: 2nd Graders should begin to develop skill levels in all areas of play ~ catching the ball, throwing, fielding (infield & outfield), hitting, base running, pitching
 - o **RULES:** 2nd Graders should have a strong knowledge of the basic rules of the game
 - o **COMPETITION:** 2nd Graders will begin to be introduced to Competition
- Safety The #1 priority of WBL is player safety at all levels of the game
 - Bat Safety: ONLY the Batter & On-Deck Batter (when in a batting cage) may have a bat in their hands
 - o **Thunder/Lightning:** Immediately halts play for a minimum of 30-minutes
 - o Rain/Field Conditions: Games will be cancelled if field conditions are unplayable
 - The league will send notices when all games/practices are cancelled
 - Coaches always reserve the right to cancel game/practice based upon their scheduled field condition
 - o **Injury:** Please ensure any injuries are immediately reported to the Coach & League Director. In the event of emergency/serious injury:

II. Coaches & Team Rosters:

- Team Rosters Team Rosters are assigned by the League Director
 - Our goal is approx. (11) players per team subject to change
 - NOTE: Rosters are LOCKED
 - Coaches/Parents may not re-assign team assignments or trade players
 - All requests for roster changes must be submitted to, and may only exclusively be granted by the League Director
- Coaches Coaching staff consists of
 - Head Coach: One (1) Head Coach
 - Assistant Coaches: Minimum of one (1) Assistant Coach
 - League may directly assign assistant coach(es) where possible/available
 - Or Head Coaches should enlist parents on team roster to assist
- Rutgers All Head & Asst Coaches must complete Rutgers Safety Training course
 - All Coaches & Asst Coaches are required to complete all Background Check requirements



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III. Uniforms & Equipment:

• Baseballs Hard Balls ~ 2nd grade begins introduction of 'hard balls'

Uniforms
 Each player receives team Hat & Jersey
 Teams
 2nd Grade will feature MLB team names

Team Equipment Each team is provided the following equipment

Baseballs (1 box of 12 baseballs ~ Hard balls)

Catcher's Gear (1 set)

First Aid Kit

Ice Packs

Player Equipment Each player is expected to provide their own equipment for

Tips: Have all players write names on hats & equipment ~ guaranteed some will be left behind Teach kids to DOUBLE knot shoelaces ~ imagine a game without a timeout to tie shoes!

Glove Players should supply their own gloveHelmet Players should supply their own helmet

NOTE: Players may NOT come to bat or be on base path without helmet

Bat WBL leagues correspond to the Babe Ruth leagues as follows:

• 2nd Grade thru Majors = USA Baseball Marking, 2 5/8" Barrel Maximum

Cleats It is preferred players wear plastic baseball cleats

At 2nd grade level, sneakers are acceptable

Baseball Pants
 Baseball Pants should be worn to all games/practices

At 2nd grade level, sweat pants are acceptable

NO SHORTS to games or practices ~ shorts are for Basketball & Soccer, not baseball

Cups All players must wear protective cups

o **Heart Guard** With introduction to Hard Balls ~ all kids must wear protective Heart Guards

IV. Season Schedule:

• **Regular Season** April 2 – June 18, 2022

o # Games (10) Games

Bye Weeks Easter weekend (April 16) & Memorial Day weekend (May 29)

Rainouts Typically are not rescheduled

V. Games:

Field Location Tamaques Park – Fields T3, T5 & T6
 Game Dates Every Saturday – (1) game per week

• **Game Times** Games times will be 2:30p & 4:30p (subject to change)

• Innings Up to 6-innings, time allowed

• Length No new inning should start 90 minutes after scheduled start time

• **Umpires** No Umpires – Coaches act as umpire



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VI. Practices:

• Field Location Franklin School or Tamagues Park – Fields T3

• **Practice Dates** Mon– Fri ~ (1) Practice per week (based upon coach schedule)

• **Practice Times** Time Slots ~ TBD (approx. 5:30p & 6:30p)

• **Length** 1-Hour

VII. Field Distances:

• Bases 60 Feet

• Pitcher's Mound

During Coach Pitch: 40 – 46-Feet (ALL coaches must pitch min. distance of 40-feet)
 During Kid Pitch: 40 – 46 Feet (ALL kids must pitch min. distance of 40-feet)

VIII. Pitching & Batting:

• **Pitching** During Coach Pitch – Coaches pitch to own team (including relief pitching)

o Coach Pitch Innings 1 & 2

Kid Pitch Innings 3 & 4 ~ after (4) balls, coach finishes at-bat for batter

Coach Pitch Inning 5

○ **Coach Discretion** Inning 6 – *if game makes it to 6 innings (Kid or Coach pitch)*

• Count 0 – 0, count starts at 0 Balls / 0 Strikes

• Balls & Strikes Coach on batting team calls Balls & Strikes

• Strike Outs YES – (3) Strikes ~ Swinging or Called

Ensure Called Strikes are clear strikes ~ objective is to get balls in play for every at bat

- During COACH PITCH, if 1st Strike of At Bat would be Called Strike ~ provide (1) warning, then call strikes (opportunity to be more liberal during Coach Pitch)
 - Reward kid pitchers who throw strikes, with Called Strikes
- Goals: Teach batters to Swing at Strikes; Reward pitchers for throwing strikes

Walks
 No walks permitted – ball must be put in play or strikeout (swinging or called)

• Outs Called Outs – baserunner removed from base (Coach consensus on outs)

Inning Ends 3-defensive outs ends the inning, or max. once thru the Batting Order

• Batting Roster Batting ~ every player at game remains in batting order

o Batting order should change week to week, or pick up where left off last game

All kids should have opportunity to bat first, last and in-between

Thrown Bats 1-warning per game, then batter is automatically CALLED OUT

For Safety Reasons with kid catchers, this rule must be enforced

IX. Catching:

- Catchers Kids Catch ~ with Coach backing up the Catcher
- Plays at Plate Base runners must slide for any play at plate and avoid catcher contact
 - No collisions of any kind or base runner is out
 - Force outs or tag outs allowed ~ no coach assistance of any kind allowed for outs
- **Dropped 3rd Strike** Batter is out no advance to 1st Base



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X. Baserunning:

• Advancing Advance to reasonable base – aggressive baserunning is prohibited

o Once defense has 'possession' of ball – base advance STOPS at nearest base

• Errors Baserunner must stop at nearest base when error occurred

• **Leading** Prohibited – base runners may not leave base until contact/ball in play

• Stealing Prohibited

XI. Fielding:

• **Positions** All player positions should ROTATE every inning

No player should be in same fielding position for more than 1-inning in a row

 All players must have opportunity to play EVERY Position, with exception of Coaches discretion for Pitchers, Catchers & 1st Base for safety reasons

Player Counts – available roster

■ 10 players – should have all players in the field (4 outfielders)

11+ players – should have 9 players in field (2+ on bench)

• No player may be on bench more than 1-inning in a row

• No player may be on bench for more than 2-innings per game

8 players – play with (2) Outfielders

Less than 8 players – borrow a defensive outfielder from opposing team

Errors No AdvanceOverthrows No Advance

XII. Coaching Positions

• At Bat (4) Bench Coach ~ required, Pitcher ~ Coach Pitch or Relief (calling strikes)

o 1st Base Coach, 3rd Base Coach

• Fielding Catcher Backup, Coaches allowed in field to provide instruction on defense

XIII. General Game Rules:

Sliding Allowed – feet first only

Balks There are No Balks by pitchers

Problems A Describing A Des

Bunting Prohibited – bunts are not allowed

• Infield Fly There is no infield fly rules

Pitcher Pickoff
 Prohibited – no leading allowed
 Catcher Pickoff
 Prohibited – no leading allowed

• Tagging Up Prohibited

XIV. Scores & Standings:

• **Scores** Scores may be kept & game winner declared (but not reported)

• **Standings** No Standings are kept for 2nd grade teams

• Playoffs No Playoffs for 2nd grade teams



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XV. Covid-19:

- Follow CURRENT New Jersey Guidelines. If sick or quarantined do not attend.
- Do not share equipment or food
- Catcher's Gear
 - o Note: kids interested in catching are encouraged to bring their own catcher's gear
 - When using team catcher's gear, please wipe down equipment between catcher's
 - o Catchers should catch 2-innings, to limit 3 catchers per game
- Postgame MAY allow post-game handshakes or high fives

 - o Players should be available June 15 July 31 for EVERY game & practice
 - Summer vacations & Sleep Away camps before August 1 preclude summer travel
 - o All Travel Team players MUST participate in Spring In-Town league

TBD: Somerset Patriots Night
 Sat, 6/18/22: Spring Regular Season Ends

TMid-June: Travel Season begins for those players who are participating

July: Summer In-Town Season

o For those interested in playing in Summer, but not on a travel team

Less competitive experience – geared more for instructional experience

September: Fall In-Town Season begins

■ October: Summer Travel Tryouts ~ 2023 Season (9U – 12U: 3rd – 6th Grade)

January 2023: Winter Training \sim at D-Bat $(K - 3^{rd} Grade)$

- Advance registration required ~ sessions book fast (additional fee)
- Training sessions typically held at D-Bat, 1x/wk on Sat & Sun from Jan Mar
- Slots fill fast, so when registration opens make sure to sign up quickly
