COACHES MAY NOT CHANGE LEAGUE RULES

- Do NOT ask another team to adjust rules. If asked, answer NO.
- If any teams play under a material rules variation BOTH TEAMS SHALL FORFEIT THE GAME!
 - Any Rules adjustments shall be SOLELY communicated by the League

I. 3rd Grade Goals & Objectives:

- FUN: The #1 goal should be for players to have fun & learn to love the game
- **SKILL DEVELOPMENT & INSTRUCTIONAL:** Spring In-Town is primarily an instructional league, and players of all abilities & skill levels are welcome. 3rd Graders should advance in their skill development in all areas of play ~ catching, throwing, fielding (*infield & outfield*), hitting, base running, pitching
- LEARN: 3rd Graders should have a complete knowledge of the basic rules of the game
- SPORTSMANSHIP: Umpires, Opponents, Coaches, Teammates, Parents
- **COMPETITION:** 3rd Grade is competitive. Player development & fun remains primary focus

II. Safety:

The #1 priority of WBL is player safety at all levels of the game

- Bat Safety: ONLY Batter & On-Deck (when in a batting cage) may have a bat in hand
- Thunder/Lightning: Immediately halts play for a minimum of 30-minutes
- Rain/Field Conditions: Games will be cancelled if field conditions are unplayable
 - The league will send notices when all games/practices are cancelled
 - Coaches always reserve the right to cancel game/practice based upon their scheduled field condition
- **Injury:** Please ensure any injuries are immediately reported to the Coach & League Director. In the event of emergency/serious injury:

III. Coaches & Team Rosters:

• **Team Rosters** Team Rosters are formed via a Draft (10-11 players per team)

- Our goal is to form evenly balanced, competitive teams
- Rosters are LOCKED ~ Coaches/Parents may not re-assign teams or trade players
- Coaching Staff (1) Head Coach; (3) Assistant Coaches
 - Coaches may enlist parents as necessary to assist with practices/games
 - Head coaches will be asked to submit player evaluations after season (for G4 Draft)

Helmet Players may <u>NOT</u> come to bat or be on the base path without a helmet

o **Bat** 2nd **Grade thru Majors** = USA Baseball Stamp, 2 5/8" Barrel Maximum

Cleats All players should wear plastic baseball cleats (metal not permitted)

Baseball Pants
 Baseball Pants should be worn to all games/practices

■ NO SHORTS to games or practices - shorts are for Basketball & Soccer, not baseball

Cups
 REQUIRED - All players must wear protective cups

Heart Guard REQUIRED - All kids must wear protective Heart Guards

O Catchers Must wear ALL gear (mask, chest protector, knee pads). MAY use own glove

• **Tip:** Have all players write names on hats & equipment ~ you will have leave behinds DOUBLE knot shoelaces ~ imagine a game without a timeout to tie shoes!

VII. Field Distances:

Bases 60 Feet

• **Pitcher's Mound** 46 Feet – Foot **MUST** be on rubber to initiate pitch

VIII. Games:

• **Field Location** Tamaques T3 (big parking lot), T5 (tennis courts) & T6 (near entrance)

Game Dates
 Every Saturday – (1) game per week
 Game Times
 10:00p & 12:15p (subject to change)

• Innings Up to 6-innings, time allowed

• **Length** 2-hours (game ends with hard stop at 120-minutes)

• Umpires Minimum of (1) Cadet Umpire

Scores/Standings Coaches must keep scores. Winning coach will report score

Games may end in tie except for playoffs

• **Playoffs** Top 4 Teams will make playoffs (1 v 4; 2 v 3; then championship)

IX. Pre-Game

• **Home Team** Takes 1st Base Dugout

• Lineups Each team will exchange lineups – ALL players remain in batting order

• Game Balls Each team will provide one (1) game ball

o Home team shall provide additional game ball if required

• Umpire Meeting Head Coaches shall meet with umpire pre-game to review rules

• START ON TIME 10a games leave field at 12p / 12:15p games leave field at 2:15p

• Time Limit No NEW inning may start after 1:45, hard stop at 12p or 2:15p

Any inning starting at/after 1 hour 45 minutes = LAST INNING

 Score of any game stopped due to time limit shall revert to the Last Full Inning

X. Game Play Basics

Fielders

Innings Max 6-innings or until time limit.

Complete game = 4 innings (due to time, weather, etc)

3.5 Innings if home team is leading = complete game

Games paused due to weather may restart, time permitting

• Run Limit Maximum 4-runs per ½ inning, except the last inning (unlimited runs)

Last Inning UMPIRE must call Last Inning PRIOR TO START of inning

If not announced BEFORE start of inning – 4 Run Rule applies

This may NOT be changed after the 1st pitch of any new inning

Mercy Rule None – Play Ball
 Defense 3-outs ends inning

Defense Coaches MUST BE INSIDE DUGOUT

o Coaches may NOT be outside dugout while on defense

Up to (10) players in field – teams may use 4 outfields at their choice

Maximum 6 players on infield dirt (including pitch & catcher)

• Teams may play with minimum of (8) fielders



3rd Grade Rules: 2023 WBL Spring In-Town Season

• Borrowed Players Borrow player(s) if required to field 8 or 9 players in field

Borrowed player(s) must be bottom of order for that inning

If Borrowed player needs to bat – last out replaces player in field

There is NO forfeit for short rosters

MAXIMUM 1-inning on bench in a row (except due to illness/injury)

EVERY PLAYER SITS ONCE before ANY Player sits twice

• Offense Coaches are ONLY permitted at 1st Base & 3rd Base coach boxes

• **Dropped 3rd Strike** Batter is OUT - no advance to 1st base

Infield Fly Rule
 Bunting
 Tagging Up
 Balks
 Pitcher Pick Off
 NOT in effect
 NOT applicable

Catcher Pick Off ALLOWED – no advance on overthrow

XI. Base Running:

Sitting

• **Leading** AFTER ball hits catcher's mitt or passed ball

• **Stealing** 3rd Base ONLY – <u>AFTER</u> ball hits catcher's mitt or passed ball

No advance to 2nd or Home under ANY circumstance unless batted ball is put in play

IE...overthrown on steal at 3rd – Runner does NOT advance

Sliding
 Feet first only. Players must slide to avoid contact on any close play.

Failure to slide which results in contact/collision = runner called out

Head First Slide into advancing base = runner called out

■ (allowed when returning to base – i.e. Pickoff or Rundown)

 Any fielder faking possession of ball, resulting in runner making unnecessary slide, will result in runner being awarded extra base (except home plate)

Max. <u>one base</u> during ENTIRE PLAY on ANY Error (i.e. per batted ball)

Defense has free shot at any base runner attempting to advance on error

Locked at 3rd
 Runner may NOT advance from 3rd to Home on ANY Error ANYWHERE

Must be batted ball/ball in play to get runner home from 3rd base

Any play/overthrow at 3rd base – runner stays put

o Runner on 2nd - ball back to pitcher & overthrow at 1st. Stay at 3rd

o Outfield overthrow to infield – runner stays at 3rd

 ONLY exception is if runner way already on way home BEFORE the error occurred – as solely determined at the UMPIRES discretion

Outfield If ball is overthrown to infield (regardless where) – max 1-base advance

Runners may advance until ball thrown to infield

Trainiers may davance aren ban en own to inner

SLOW DOWN Rule When ahead by 10-runs – NO STEALING OR ADVANCING ON ERRORS

Speed Up Rule Catchers may have substitute runner ONLY with 2-outs

Substitute with player who made last out

Injured Baserunner May be replaced with player who made last out

Pitcher's Mound
 Play ends when ball is returned to pitcher's mound

XII. Pitching Rules:

Distance Distance MUST be 46-feet – Kid Pitch entire game
 Pitching Rules 1 pitch = 1 inning (i.e. debate relief with 2-outs)

- Maximum <u>TWO</u> Innings per game (up to limit of 75 pitches)
- Maximum <u>THREE</u> Innings in any 2-game period

• **Rubber** Pitchers must be on rubber to start delivery

• Warm-ups Max 8 warm-ups in 1st inning, max 5 warm-ups each remaining inning

• **Count** 0 – 0, count starts at 0 Balls / 0 Strikes

• Walks 4 balls = walk

• **Strike Outs** 3 Strikes = Strike out

• **Hit by Pitch** Awarded 1st Base (after 3 hit batters, pitcher must be removed)

• Mound Visits Maximum 1 per pitcher per inning. 2nd visit in inning – pitcher removed

- Umpire Calls Balls & Strikes Do not argue, comment or question any call!
- Any player who pitches 2-innings, may NOT catch that game
- Any player who catches 2-innings, may NOT pitch that game

XIII. Batting Rules:

- Batting Roster Batting every player at game remains in batting order
 - Bottom 3 in batting order may NOT be among bottom 3 again in any 2-game period
- Thrown Bats 1-warning PER TEAM per game, then batter is automatically CALLED OUT
 - For Safety Reasons with kid catchers, this rule must be enforced
- **Lineup** Lineup spot skipped without penalty for player injured, ill or leaving early
- Late Arrivals Must be put at END of batting order and await normal turn in order to bat

XIV. Catching:

- **Catchers** Kids Catchers
- Plays at Plate Base runners must slide for any play at plate and avoid catcher contact
 - No collisions of any kind or base runner is out

XV. Fielding:

- Positions MAXIMUM of 2-innings at any one position during ENTIRE GAME
 - o Every player plays minimum 2-innings of infield
 - Every player should play at least 2-innings of outfield
 - Pitchers, Catchers, 1st Base at Coaches discretion (based upon pitching rules)
 - All players should have opportunity at all other infield positions (2B, SS, 3B)

XVI. Sportsmanship:

- Umpires these are cadets. Bad calls are expected. Bad behavior will result in expulsion.
 - o Arguing with umpires is strictly prohibited accept the call and move on
 - WBL reserves the right to remove any coach who harasses an umpire
 - DO NOT COMMENT on any ball/strike calls your opinion DOES NOT MATTER
 - Only the serving Head Coaches for the game may review rules with umpires
- **Pitching** when pitcher is on the rubber, the opposing team is silent.
 - Violation of this rule will result in the batter being called OUT
- Players arguing/talking back to an umpire, results in an OUT & a sit for next 2-innings
 - Kicking/rattling screens or player distraction including catchers talking to batters with intent to distract is strictly prohibited
 - Harassing another player or unsportsmanlike conduct results in sit for 2-innings
- Teams must clean dugout following game even if you did not leave it behind
- Parents are FANS, not coaches. Cheer, but do not coach from the stands.
 - ANY parent harassing or speaking directly to umpire, will result in game stoppage until
 parent leaves the field. If parent refuses the offending team forfeits the game.

XVII. Scores, Standings & Playoffs:

- **Scores** Coaches must keep score winning team reports score
 - Winning team must include pitching roster & # innings pitched
- Report Score Report by Sunday to: jaycofresi@gmail.com
- **Standings** Will be posted on WBL website <u>www.westfieldbaseball.com</u>
 - O Win = 3 points
 - o Tie = 2 points
 - Loss = 1 point
 - Forfeit = 0 points (If one team causes forfeit, opponent shall be awarded 2 points)
 - Incomplete game = 0 points
- Standings Tie for Playoffs
 - Head to Head results / Fewest Runs allowed in all games played / Coin Flip
 - 3-Way Tie: If all teams have played, any team has beaten other 2 teams
 - Fewest Runs allowed in all games played
 - Coin Flip (if 2 teams), or Random Draw for playoff spot (if multiple teams)
- Playoffs Final Week of Season (Sat, June 10) Regular Season rules except noted
 - Consolation Games 10:00a (Higher seed is home team for all playoff games)
 - **T5** $9 \times 10 / T6 7 \times 8 / T3 5 \times 6$
 - Playoff Games 12:15p (Higher seed is home team for all playoff games)
 - **T6**-2 v 3 / **T3**-1 v 4
 - No Players may be borrowed fewer than 8 = forfeit
 - Extra Innings if required
 - Championship Game Week of June 11: Time TBD / Field TBD
 - Daylight permitting there shall be no time limit. Play 6 innings.
 - Extra Innings if required.

Pitch Smart Guidelines

www.mlb.com/pitch-smart/pitching-guidelines/ages-9-12

Ages 9 & Under (46' Pitching Distance)

- Focus on athleticism, physical fitness, and fun
- Focus on learning baseball rules, general techniques, and teamwork
- Do not exceed 80 combined innings pitched in any 12 month period
- Take at least 4 months off from throwing every year, with at least 2-3 of those months being continuous
- Make sure to properly warm up before pitching
- Set and follow pitch-count limits and required rest periods
- Avoid throwing pitches other than fastballs and change-ups
- Avoid playing for multiple teams at the same time
- Avoid playing catcher while not pitching
- Players should not pitch in multiple games on the same day
- Play other sports during the course of the year
- Monitor for other signs of fatigue
- Pitchers once removed from the mound may not return as pitchers
- No pitcher shall appear in a game as a pitcher for three consecutive days, regardless of pitch counts

9-10	75	1-20	21-35	36-50	51-65	66+

NOTES:

5 batters = approx. 25 pitches (avg. 5 pitches per batter)
4 run inning = approx. 40 to 50 pitches (8 to 10 batters)
In-Town RULE = MAX 2-inning limit per game
