I. General League Notes:

- Goals & Objectives
 - o **FUN:** The #1 goal should be for players to have fun & learn to love the game
 - INSTRUCTIONAL: Spring In-Town is primarily an instruction league, and players of all abilities & skill levels are welcome
 - Expect all levels of ability & experience
 - SKILL DEVELOPMENT & FUNDAMENTALS: Pre-K and Kindergarten children need to be taught basic skills (catching, throwing, hitting, base running, fielding) & basic rules (field positions, base running, where to throw ball)
 - o **RULES:** Pre-K/K should be introduced to basic rules of the game
 - o **COMPETITION:** Pre-K/K is about fun & skill development NOT Competition
- Safety The #1 priority of WBL is player safety at all levels of the game
 - o Bat Safety: ONLY Batter may have a bat in hand
 - o **Thunder/Lightning:** Immediately halts play for a minimum of 30-minutes
 - o Rain/Field Conditions: Games will be cancelled if field conditions are unplayable
 - The league will send notices when all games/practices are cancelled
 - Coaches always reserve the right to cancel game/practice based upon their scheduled field condition
 - o **Injury:** Please ensure any injuries are immediately reported to the Coach & League Director. In the event of emergency/serious injury:

II. Coaches & Team Rosters:

• **Team Rosters** Team Rosters are assigned by the League Director

- Our goal is approx. (11) players per pre-k team and 12 per Kindergarten
- NOTE: Rosters are LOCKED
 - Coaches/Parents may not re-assign team assignments or trade players
 - All requests for roster changes must be submitted to, and may only exclusively be granted by the League Director
- Coaches Coaching staff consists of
 - o Head Coach: One (1) Head Coach
 - Assistant Coaches: Minimum of one (1) Assistant Coach
 - League may directly assign assistant coach(es) where possible/available
 - Head Coaches should enlist parents on team roster to assist
- Rutgers All Head & Asst Coaches must complete Rutgers Safety Training course
- Background/SAFE All Head & Asst Coaches must complete background checks & SAFE training



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IV. Uniforms & Equipment:

Baseballs Safety Balls

• Uniforms Each player receives team Hat & Jersey

• **Teams** Pre-K – 4th Grade features major league team uniforms

Team Equipment Each team is provided the following equipment

- Baseballs (1 box of 12 baseballs ~ Safety balls)
- o Tee
- Drop Bases
- o First Aid Kit
- o Ice Packs
- Player Equipment Each player is expected to provide their own equipment for
 - Tips: Write names on hats & equipment ~ guaranteed some will be left behind

 Teach kids to DOUBLE knot shoelaces ~ imagine a game without a timeout to tie shoes!
 - Glove Players should supply their own glove
 Helmet Players should supply their own helmet
 - NOTE: No Helmet = No At-Bat. No Exceptions!
 - Bat WBL leagues correspond to the Babe Ruth leagues as follows:
 - Kindy = USA Baseball T-Ball Stamp
 - O T-Ball (bats 27" and smaller only, 28" bats fall into Cal Ripken Baseball)

 - Cleats It is preferred players wear plastic baseball cleats
 - At Kindergarten level, sneakers are acceptable
 - Baseball Pants
 Baseball Pants should be worn to all games/practices
 - At Kindergarten level, sweat pants are acceptable
 - Discourage SHORTS for games & practices ~ teach baseball basics
 - shorts are for Basketball & Soccer, not baseball
 - o Heart Guards Heart guard undershirts are recommended but not required

• Game Times Games times will be @ 11am, 12:30, 2:00 and 3:30 (subject to change)

30-minute arrival & warm-ups

Innings 3-innings, time allowed



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• **Length** 90-minutes (20 min practice, 60 min game - game ends with hard stop

at 90-minutes)

• Umpires No Umpires

VII. Practices:

• Field Location Jefferson J1, J2, J3 & J4 (Mon – Fri 5:30p; 6:30p)

• **Practice Dates** Mon – Fri ~ (1) Practice per week (based upon coach schedule)

• **Practice Times** Time Slots ~ 5:30p & 6:30p

• **Length** 1-Hour

VIII. Field Distances:

• Bases approx. 40 Feet

• Pitching Tee Ball – 100% for Pre-k, 100% for first (6) Kindergarten Games

IX. Pitching & Batting:

• **Pitching** If Coach Pitch – MAXIMUM (4) Pitches ~ then revert to Tee

IT IS LESS ABOUT THE BATTER – DON'T LOSE THE DEFENSE INTEREST

• **Count** No Count – no balls or strikes

• Strike Outs No

• Walks — ball must be put in play

Outs — Base Runners Stay on base, advance maximum 1-base

• Inning Ends Once thru the Batting Order

Last Batter Hits Grand Slam & Clears bases (Keep Defense on field till reach home plate)

• **Batting** Roster Batting ~ every player bats each inning

Batting order should change week to week

All kids should have opportunity to bat first, last and in-between

• Thrown Bats Teach players NOT to throw their bats

X. Catching:

• Catchers — Tee Ball (or Coach catchers during Coach Pitch)

• Plays at Plate None

XI. Baserunning:

• Advancing 1st Base Only – regardless of hit

Errors No ErrorsLeading No LeadingStealing No Stealing

XII. Fielding:

Positions All player positions should ROTATE every inning

o TIP: ½-way through inning ~ Flip Flop infield and outfield to keep interest

o All kids play in field - no sitting

• **Pitcher** Keep coach near pitcher for safety (balls can come fast off tee)



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XIII. Coaching Positions

- At Bat (4) Bench Coach (required), Tee, 1st Base, 3rd Base
 - o TIP: Line up kids along fence in Batting Order
 - TIP: Bats stay lined along fence or put in a bucket NO BATS IN HAND
 - NO EXCEPTIONS
- **Fielding** Coaches allowed in field to provide instruction on defense

XIV. General Game Rules:

• Sliding Allowed – feet first only

• Balks Not Applicable – No Pitchers

Bunting No Bunts – Tee Ball
 Infield Fly No Infield Fly Rule

Pitcher Pickoff
 Not Applicable – No Pitchers
 Catcher Pickoff
 Not Applicable – No Catchers

Tagging Up
 Not Applicable – No Outs, Maximum 1-base per batter
