

## The Barrel Blanks K&R Blue, Weiland's Holds Lead Pace

Weiland's held onto its Western Division lead in the Chicora Softball League this past weekend by defeating the Moose with a late rush, 9-3.

That meant runnerup Barrel members had to produce a matching conquest against K&R Blue, top team in the Eastern circuit, and they made good with Ralph Geibel pitching a 2-0 four-hit shutout.

The Blue was left with a two-game edge in the lost column over Landmark, who vanquished Kevin's, 8-6. Weiland's and The Barrel are still one stride apart. Woodbine out-slugged K&R Red in a battle of 15-hitters, 22-19, to go one game over .500 (14-13).

Tom McPherson doubled and singled twice in backing Geibel's shut-out twirling. And catcher Gary Kildoo supported his batterymate with one of each.

Dave Emrick and Joe Steiner each doubled and singled to lead the Weiland team, Deasn Fedoric and Joe Keifer matching them for the Moose.

Landmark scored three times in the eighth and ninth to finish ahead of Kevin's. Biz Dodd sparkled with his round tripper and two one-baggers, Jeff Craig was tough with a single and two doubles, and Bill Terwilliger singled and doubled. Brian Smith stroked a double and two singles for Kevin's, Ralph Cranmer booking three singles.

Woodbine put four on the board in the top of the ninth and it turned out to be a needed rally as K&R Red scored six times in its final try.

Larry Graham worked the winning hill and also doubled and homered. Jacy Bellis contributed a HR and single, Jerome Young a triple and single, and Rick Bresnehan two singles. Jay Fleegeer singled three times for The Red.
