Team location and park:

Number of players committed:

To express the number of players and level of commitment, I feel in necessary to advise that I put out a radio add and Facebook post notifying people of an open tryout at Tom Williams Baseball Field. 5 days later we hosted the first tryout, at which 18 people showed up ready to go. Where players are coming from:

Most players are coming from the Owen Sound Minor Baseball Association in their roots, though some have had to move on and play elsewhere in recent years due to there being nowhere to play after the midget level.

Relationship to Minor Ball:

We have no direct relationship to minor baseball in Owen Sound. We are however hoping that having a senior team back in Owen Sound will bring kids out to the ball field and inspire them to play with amazing game, as it did for a lot of us growing up watching North Dufferin Baseball.

Field Days/Times:

Specific days and times for booking the baseball field is not available this far in advance, but I have had conversation with City of Owen Sound parks employees, and have been advised that getting diamond times will not be an issue.

Coaching:

We will have three player/coaches for the team:

I have been approached from several other people interested in helping, but I cannot commit them to paper yet.

Financial:

Our finances will come from player team fees of \$300 per player. I have already received 16x\$300 from players that have paid.

We have also received commitments from two local businesses to support us financially:

- Smith's Home Hardware = \$1000
- Zuchora's Masonry = \$1000

One other business had pledged a financial commitment, but the details have not been finalized yet.

A humble Request:

We would like to respectfully request that the vote to determine whether or not we will be allowed in the league for the 2022 season be done as soon as possible. I am available to attend any location, or virtually in order to facilitate this.

In the event that we are accepted into the league, there is a lot that still needs to be done logistically for us before spring and the start of a new season! Creating and ordering uniforms, and team equipment may very well be faced with delays given our current world climate. We also have arrangements with our sponsors for advertising that may take some time to organise and complete.
