Hello Scott and NDBL members

On behalf of Bradford Minor Baseball, we will have a 22U team for the 2025 season and would like to join the North Dufferin Baseball League. Bradford had two 18U teams in 2024, and most players want to continue playing Rep baseball. At this time, I have 15 players on my roster and am available to call up players from two more 18U teams in Bradford if needed. However, I do not see a need to do that as the players are all committed to playing.

The majority of the players are 18/19 years old to start the season but have played at AA and AAA levels, so based on watching the level of play in 22U in the NDBL in 2024, we feel we will have a competitive team.

Our team name is the Bradford Tigers. We have two mounded fields in the north end of Bradford on line 11 as part of a 5-diamond complex. A third mounded diamond is slated for 2026 in the same complex. All our diamonds have lights.

Our home night is scheduled for Sunday evenings at 7pm and we have access to the diamonds most weekends as they are not used as much. Week night games could be challenging as there are 7 teams that use these diamonds in Bradford. However, if needed we can always work something out with a team on their practice night or a Friday evening. Since we do have lights, we have two time slots each night and all weekend accessibility.

I will be the Head Coach of the team and should have 1 or 2 assistant Coaches. We have all our required OBA certifications as Coaches.

Our fees are paid to Bradford Minor Baseball which covers Umpires, the fields, and baseballs. We have a team fee as well to cover the NDBL fee, the tournaments we are entering, one in July (4th to 6th) and OBAs. We have funds for equipment from the local and team funds. Insurance will be paid via the local Board.

I look forward to attending the NDBL AGM in March and presenting our team to the membership.
