Important takeaways from the Lineman 5v5 Coaches Certification

- 5v5 rosters will remain open all season. New players may be added on throughout the season. Players will weigh-in every game day. Therefore, there is no minimum number of players required per roster.
- “New” teams will be formed by the players that check-in and matched based on age and/or weight. *Please notify parents ahead of time so they know players will be mixed and matched for games.*
- All coaches expressed support to coach players from different chapters in order to support their development.

#### Information for ALL LINEMAN TEAMS:

- *All players must have soft helmets, softshell shoulder pads, and mouthpieces to participate. No exceptions.*
- *All lineman 5v5 games will be on Field 2.*

#### Check-in Procedures for ALL LINEMAN TEAMS:

The check-in tent is located by the restroom/snack bar area. Look for the red Boost tent.

1. Turn in missing paperwork. Any player packets that were redlined at registration may be updated and added back to the roster at check-in.
2. Add new players with proper paperwork by handwriting them at the bottom of the roster (before approaching the table).
  - a. Player Contract (front and back) 2 copies (one for Boost, one for coach)
  - b. Headshot
  - c. Proof of Age Document
  - d. Boost Waiver
3. **Mark absent players with an “A”, and get the roster signed off by Stacie or Boost Staff.**

- The goal is to add more teams and girls as the season progresses.
