TCBA Concession Stand

Please read the Concession Stand Policies and Obligations below before signing up for Concession Stand volunteer hours.

Concession Stand Policies

- Sign up for time slots will be done through SignUp.com
- A SignUp notification email to be sent out by the Concession Stand Manager
- Shifts are available on a first come first serve basis
- Shifts will begin on opening day and continue through the end of the season
- Volunteers must be 18 years old and older
- Children are not permitted in the stand
- Please arrive for your shift **ON TIME (10 minutes early)**
- Arrivals exceeding 15 minutes past the scheduled start time will result in the shift being marked as unfulfilled. You will be required to sign up for another shift.
- Concession deposit fees are per family
- One, 1 hour shift, per family is required
- For any rainouts determined **PRIOR** to the teams reporting to Memorial Field, you would **NOT** need to report to the concession stand for your shift
- If a rainout occurs, your obligation has been fulfilled
- Fees will be returned to you , either through Venom or check, when you've worked your designated shift. Failure to work your shift will result in your fee being deposited.
- Concession Stand Deposit fee amounts: **\$100 per family.**

*** You do have the option of just paying the deposit fee to the TCBA and opting out of the volunteer commitment. Please notify the Director of Concessions if you intend to opt out of the volunteer requirement. However, the TCBA would prefer that each family volunteers. The point of this program is to provide great customer service for our community, build strong relationships and showcase our organization as one of the best run programs in the WNY area.

Concession Stand Obligations

Requirements

House League Players

One, 1 hour, shift **per family** will be required per each House League players' family. If you have players in multiple leagues, you are only required to volunteer **ONE** shift for your family. It is **NOT** one shift per league.

- A family is defined as the physical address used for registration and the registered players that are associated with that physical address.
- A family who has a Head Coach or an Assistant Coach of a House League team is **exempt** from their volunteer Concession Duties. That family is still welcome to volunteer, however, they are **NOT** required to volunteer.
