- 2. All umpires, paid and volunteer, will be required to attend a pre-season Umpire Traning Clinic.April 10th 1pm at East Central College
- 3. Every team will be required to select an official scorekeeper and that scorekeeper will be required to attend a pre-season Scorekeeper's Clinic even if they are familiar with keeping an official score book.
 - April 10th 3pm at East Central College
- 4. The Home Team will be required to keep the official scorebook, remove equipment (bases and such) from the field after their game, and set up the field for play. The Visiting Team will be required to provide one or two volunteers for the concession stand.

We realize that these changes are very different than anything we've ever done before, and we realize it will take some time to get used to them. Please understand we want to improve this league and the only way that will happen is with your cooperation. When we unite for a common purpose, we can do anything!
