Where Are They Now?

Kevin Kline is a 2007 graduate of Waynesboro Area Senior High School. He was a 4-year member of the varsity squad and reached the 1,000 point plateau during his senior season. He is currently in his senior year at Shenandoah University, majoring in business administration and a background in sports management. Kevin has been selected to numerous all-tournament teams during his collegiate career in the USA South Conference. During his sophomore year, he was 2nd

Team All-Conference and as a junior, his scoring average (3rd highest in the league) helped him to garner 1st-Team All-Conference honors. Kevin has been recognized as an “ESPN: The Magazine” 1st Team All-Academic selection. At the conclusion of his junior season, Kevin stood 137 points shy of becoming just the 16th player in Shenandoah history to reach 1,000 points in their career. Kevin is on target to graduate in May 2011 and hopes to become an athletic director or obtain a position in sports management. He
