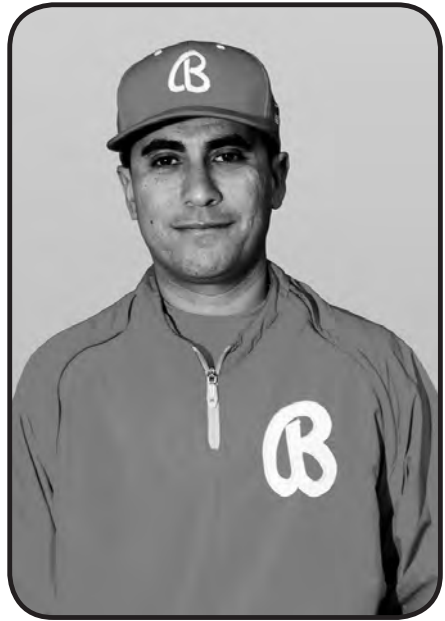

HEAD COACH NICK OZUNA III

As Head Coach of the Cardinals, Nick Ozuna III, is not stranger to Bellaire High School or the rich tradition of the Bellaire Baseball Program. Prior to being named Bellaire Baseball Head Coach in 2017, Coach Ozuna was an Assistant on staff from 2005 – 2016. In addition to working for Bellaire High School for more than a decade, he is a 1994 graduate of BHS and was the starting shortstop for Bellaire's 1994 5A State Championship team. Ozuna was inducted into the Bellaire Baseball Hall of Fame in 2000, for his accomplishments are a player under legendary Coach Rocky Manuel. Prior to the 2016 season, Coach Ozuna was named Assistant Head Coach of the Bellaire Cardinals. "I can't say enough about what I learned as a player and assistant from Coach Manuel; about this great game we teach to our players but more important than that, besides my DAD, no other person has taught me more about how to be a man. I hope to have the same impact on my players as Head Coach."



In 12 years as an Assistant, Coach Ozuna has served in many different roles. From 2005-2007, his primary responsibility was coaching the infielders, while also coaching 1st base. In his first four years, his impact on the program was taking shape as 26 players went on to play collegiate baseball. In 2007, the Cardinals won 31 games in a row, the second longest winning streak in school history. That June, Senior SS Matt West was selected in the 2nd round of the MLB amateur draft by the Texas Rangers. West went on to make his Major League debut with the Rangers in 2014.

One year later, in 2008, Coach Ozuna was called upon to change roles and become the Cardinal Pitching Coach. That year, the Bellaire pitching staff posted an anemic ERA of 1.00, that led all of greater Houston as they marched into the state playoffs, which ended in Round Rock in the State Championship Semi-Finals game. Coach Ozuna served as Pitching Coach from 2008 -2011, producing eight college pitchers, with two of those making it to the professional level. Tyler Duffey made his MLB debut with the Minnesota Twins in 2015, and Toller Boardman was drafted by the Detroit Tigers in 2015. Coach Ozuna was coached eight other Bellaire players that have made it to the professional ranks and over 70 players that he has coached have gone on to play at the collegiate level.

From 2012-2015, Coach Ozuna's role expanded even more, as he went back to coaching outfielders. He assisted Coach Tedder with the hitters, worked with

base runners and bunters, coached first base, was in charge of defensive position during games, and was the lead scout of opponents. Reflecting on the last five years, Coach Ozuna shared, “My role as a Coach really amped up. I credit Coach Manuel for putting me in those different positions and giving me more responsibility. It was really good for my development as a coach.”



Coach Ozuna grew up in southwest Houston with his Mom, Dad, and two brothers, both of whom played for the Cardinals. His brother Matt, a 1997 graduate, was on the Bellaire team that recorded the greatest comeback in a Texas high school baseball play-off game, down 11-0, with 2 outs in the bottom of the 7th, the Cards struck for 12 runs to win the game, and eventually went on to win the 2 out of 3 series. Matt is currently Vice President of Financial Counseling at Ayco, a division of Goldman Sachs Private Wealth Management. Coach Ozuna’s mom was a teacher in Spring Branch ISD and Houston ISD, and finished her 35-year career in education in Alief ISD, where she spent 29 years at the same school before retiring in 2015.

Coach Ozuna’s dad, Nick Jr., did Project Engineering and oil industry work, spending his last 15 years working as a Senior Project Manager for a private home builder, developing sub-divisions before retiring in 2015. He coached off season Bellaire in the 90’s, working with the eventual 1999 National Championship team. He has also been active within the Kyle Chapman Pony League since 1989; making a World Series run in 2003, and managing the KC team to a World Series Title in 2009. “I guess it is safe to say, I come from a baseball family. I learned so much from my Dad about the game growing up.” In addition to his father, Coach Ozuna credits his Kyle Chapman coaches Mike Winner, the late Ted Harris, and Steve Ricks for helping in his development and love for the game. Also, in addition to his high school coach, Rocky Manuel, off season coaches at Bellaire, Jerry Davanon, Dick Burris, and Butch Ghutzman were instrumental in helping Coach Ozuna take his game to the next level. In 1994, Coach Ozuna achieved what every high school baseball player dreams of, as his Bellaire Cardinals team went 36-3-1, and captured the sixth State Championship for Bellaire High School. “That was a surreal experience. We almost didn’t get out of the first round and then it all came together over the next five weeks. Everyone playing not just for yourself and your own family, but for the guy next to you and their family, and the guy next to him, and so on. That’s what I know can happen here again, if these guys just believe in themselves and believe in one another. I’m big into that, supporting each other through thick and thin.”

After graduating from Bellaire in 1994, Coach Ozuna earned a scholarship to

play Division I baseball and continue his education at Same Houston State University. In 1996, his Bearkat team, won the Southland Conference Tournament Championship, which earned them a berth to the Regional NCAA Tournament, hosted by the University of Texas at Disch Faulk field. The Bearkats, shocked the #1 team in the country, by beating the Miami Hurricanes, before eventually losing to the Texas Longhorns and UCLA, to end their great run. In 1998, Coach Ozuna transferred to Houston Baptist University, where he played for one year and finish his double major degree in Business Administration and Business Management.

From 200-2003, Coach worked as a NASD Registered Representative and was a licensed Series 7, 63,55 and 4 broker. He traded and account for Pro Trader Partner, Michael Zatorski, who Coach Ozuna also credits for helping him get his start in business and giving him a chance, before making a career change into Education and Coaching. When aske about the transition from businessman to educator, Coach Ozuna replied, "It sounds cliché but ware are in the people business and in the business of helping kids. This is an investment these kids and parents are making to be a part of Bellaire Baseball. I'm talking about in terms of time and commitment and understanding it's a process. Not everyone is able to play baseball in college or play professionally, but everyone can leave Bellaire High School, college bound and have a profession if they work hard enough."

Bellaire's rich academic heritage is the foundation. "Excellence in Academics and Athletes" is the motto of Bellaire Baseball. In addition to athletic development, coach Ozuna wants to promote a culture of personal development by instilling values such as teamwork, work ethic, competitiveness, and perseverance. All players are expected to exhibit excellence, by being, Great in the Classroom, Great on the Field, and Great



in the Community.

In 2004, Coach Ozuna was hired by Westbury High School where we went through and ACT (Alternative Certification for Teachers) program to earn his K-12 Teacher Certification. He was assisted the Westbury Varsity Baseball team to double digit wins for the first time in nearly a decade. The rest is history; that fall, in 2004 he was hired by former Bellaire Principal, Tim sale, CTE Department Chair, Elizabeth Kelm, and Head Coach Rocky Manuel. He credits all three for making it happen and helping him in the classroom as a Career and Technology Education teacher and on the field as a baseball coach. Coach Ozuna married his high school sweetheart, the former Melissa Workman in 2005, and in 2006, they welcomed twin boys, Vincent and Dominic. In 2008, daughter Nina, was born. All three kids are involved in sports, with the boys playing for Bellaire Little League and Nina playing softball for WUSA. What Coach and Melissa Ozuna are most proud of though, is the academic achievement and great education that their children are getting at Lovett Elementary.

Cardinal Baseball’s legacy has had three big chapters. The first started by Coach Howard Allen, winning the first State Championship in 1960. The second, started two years later with Coach Ray Knoblauch winning four State Championships in 1962, 1971, 1978, and 1986. The third chapter was led by Coach Rocky Manuel, taking it all in 1994 and 1999, and having some great runs thereafter. Coach Ozuna leads the Bellaire Cardinals forward with this message, “the hardest thing to do in amateur of professional sports is to repeat as a champion or to replace a legend or legacy of coaches, but Bellaire High School and our Community is ready for the next Cardinal Legacy to begin. I embrace that and look forward to the challenge.”

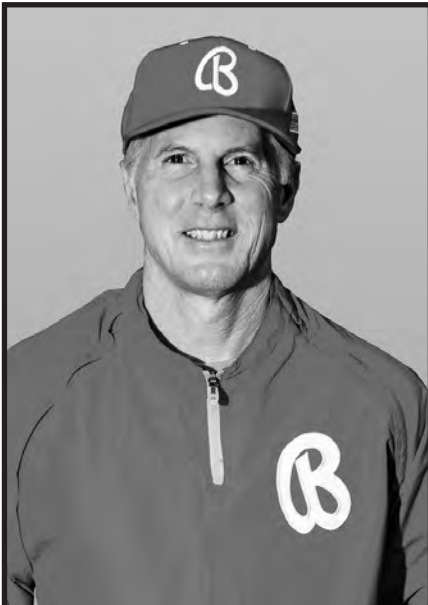


**Junior Varsity Coach

The Randolph Edward Murff Award

In recognition of character and leadership, the Murff Award is given annually to a Bellaire Baseball Senior in memory of Randy Murff.

Randy Murff was a 1993 graduate of Bellaire High School, an honor roll student and 4-year letterman in both baseball and football. Randy graduated from Columbia University with Honors in 1997. While at Columbia, Randy continued his football career, earning the 1993 Offensive Athlete of the Year Award, and was named to the All Ivy League Team and Columbia Team of the 90's.

Pursing a lifelong dream to fly, Randy joined the U.S. Air Force, graduating in the top 10% of his class and attaining the rank of 1st Lieutenant. On June 12, 2001, 1st Lieutenant Randolph Edward Murff was fatally injured serving his country in South Korea.
