

**West York Soccer Club
Code of Ethics/Code of Conduct**

Players:

- ◆ Display good sportsmanship at all times before, during and after all games and practice sessions. It is the desire of the West York Soccer Club's Board of Directors that all WYSC team members receive recognition as the best sportsmen in the league.
- ◆ No foul, or other wise objectionable, language or gestures will be permitted.
- ◆ During games, play by the rules at all times. Intentionally breaking the rules, such as intentionally rough play, is not permitted.
- ◆ Taunting of opponents or criticism of teammates is not allowed. Always encourage your teammates and display team unity.
- ◆ Talking back to an official or questioning an official's judgment about a call or lack of a call is not permitted. If you think that you have been treated unfairly, then bring the matter to the attention of your coaches.
- ◆ Before, during and after any game or practice the use of alcohol, tobacco products or other drugs (except over the counter drugs and prescription drugs) is strictly prohibited. If you take regular prescription drugs, i.e. asthma, please inform the coaches.

Parents and Spectators:

- ◆ Display good sportsmanship at all time before, during and after all games and practice sessions. It is the desire of the West York Soccer Club's Board of Directors that all WYSC parents and spectators receive recognition as the best fans in the league.
- ◆ No foul, or otherwise objectionable, language or gestures will be permitted.
- ◆ During the games and at practice sessions, encourage the team through positive motivational comments and cheering.
- ◆ Taunting of opponents is not allowed.
- ◆ Talking back to an official or questioning an official's judgment about a call is not permitted. If you think that the team has been treated unfairly, then bring the matter to the attention of the coaches.
- ◆ The team can receive a yellow card or red card if spectators get out of control. Please consider this when you are cheering for your team. Coaches have been instructed to ask any spectator that causes a problem during a game to leave the facility.
- ◆ We expect parents to monitor this Code of Ethics during all games and practices. If you witness a breach of these rules by a coach, player or parents, please inform one of the coaches immediately so that any reoccurrence can be eliminated. If you witness repeated violations, please contact the WYSC President: Jim Zimmerman, 767-4560.

Failure to follow this code of conduct, either by a player or by associated parents and spectators, may result in the player being permanently removed from the team without a refund of registration or uniform fees.
