The Klein Collins Baseball Booster club is organized to provide financial support to the Klein Collins Baseball Team's actual and recurring costs. Klein Independent School District apportions \$2,500 per year to the Baseball program which is inadequate to meet the basic costs to run the program. It takes on average \$20,000 per year to meet the basic needs of the program.

As President of the Klein Collins Baseball Booster Club, I am reaching out to you in request of community support of this organization as a local business sponsor. A typical baseball season has on average 65 scheduled home games split between Varsity, Junior Varsity, and Sophomore teams, up to 3 area tournaments, and in the past, we have added 4 to 6 playoff home games.

At each game we host between 75 and 150 visiting players, coaches, college scouts, fans, and extended family members. So, a conservative estimate of, 10,000 -12,000 Houston Metro area residents per season enjoying our facility, looking at our outfield billboards, and strolling past our walk-up signs as you enter the park.
