All teams will be ASA sanctioned and governed by ASA rules with these exceptions:

- 1. No player nine (9) years or older as of January 1 is eligible. Birth certificates will be checked.
- $2. \ Team\ rosters,\ ASA\ sanction\ numbers,\ birth\ certificates\ and\ tournament\ fees\ must\ be\ turned\ in\ before\ first\ pool\ play$

game.

- 3. Home team will be decided by a coin flip in pool play, higher seed in bracket play. Home team keeps official book.
- 4. All players on the roster may bat in a continuous order. Must bat at least 9. Teams with only 8 players must take an out.
- 5. Ten (10) player defense, traditional infield and four (4) outfield positions. Outfielders must start in the grass.
- 6. Pool Play Games are six (6) innings or 1hr 10 minutes. No new inning after 1hr.
- 7. If the ball goes out of play, it is that base plus one.
- 8. Infield fly rule will not be in effect.
- 9. Courtesy runners may be used for catchers. Courtesy runners consist of the last out recorded.
- 10. Hitters get five (5) pitches (or 3 swinging strikes). If 5_{th} pitch is fouled, the batter continues and will continue as long

as the batter continues to foul pitches.

- 11. Player playing pitcher must keep one foot in the circle until pitch is released.
- 12. If coach pitcher is struck with the ball, it is a dead ball and that pitch does not count. Runners must go back to their

base.

- 13. When pitching, coach pitcher must have one foot on the pitcher mound (rubber) and move off to the side of field during play, returning once time has been called.
- 14. When the ball is in the infield, in control of a defensive player and the lead runner has been stopped, the umpire will
- call "Time" and proceed to the next batter. Getting the ball into the circle will not stop the play.
- 15. Catchers must be in a squatting position during the pitch. Batters/runners will be called "safe" if the catcher makes

an out, but does not start in a squat position.

- 16. Runners may not leave the base, until the ball crosses home plate.
- 17. Runner obstruction will be enforced. Fielders must give runners the base, if no play is being made at their base.
- 18. 6 run max per inning.
- 19. Mercy Rule (13 runs after 4 innings, 7 runs after 5 innings).
- 20. Pool play game may end in a tie.
- 21. Bracket seeding will be determined by (1) record, (2) head-to-head, (3) runs against, (4) runs scored, (5) coin flip.
- 22. International tie-breaker rule for bracket games that are tied after six (6) innings or have reached their time limit.

Last out of previous inning will start on 2nd base.
