Meeting Minutes:

Winter Indoor Lacrosse - Tasha/James

It was reported that we have 33 players that have paid to play in the winter off season. 4 players paid for fall but not for winter so 37 total players have played in the offseason at some point.

Waivers & the roster will be finalized 1/12 and turned in prior to the game on 1/13. The fee for Winter was paid when the Fall league payment was due and was discounted \$25 for early payment with final payment of \$975.

Registration & Enrollment - Tasha

As of the meeting 42 players have paid and 46 have made the team commitment. At this time it is possible there will be 1 full scholarship and 1 ½ scholarship, 2 other players have made payment arrangement at a later date.

Enrollment at this time shows just under 60 players but some of those players have decided not to return and several are new freshman. It is estimated that we will have over 52 players, but will not field an L3 team. There will be some additional games schedule at the JV level to increase the playing time for all players on this team.

Finances - Brian

The financial balance at this time is roughly \$42,000 The bills that are outstanding at this time include fall apparel \$1393, Spring Helmets \$9090, Field Lines from 2017 \$788, 2018 Varsity Uniforms estimated cost \$5000, Spring Player Packs Apparel \$8400, Spring Break Plane Tickets Balance \$11,000. Estimated Income from January & February Payments should be roughly \$20,000 with 50 players paying.

Apparel & Equipment Ordering – James

It was voted and decided that we would order 60 player packs, even though numbers aren't there yet. The order will be placed off the current 42 registered players with 8 additional medium and 8 additional large player packs. The players pack includes: 3 practice shooter shirts, 1 game shooter shirt, 1 practice short, 1 reversible numbered pinny and 1 player team polo. These will be ordered January 12th. Optional apparel will included such things as a hoody, jacket, long sleeve shooter shirt, cleats, tights, additional practice shorts, practice shirts, & polos. The Optional apparel with be

available to order starting February 1 and the deadline to order will be February 10th. Brian, James & Tasha will meet to price, document and create the registration to go live by February 1.
