Baseball rules

Bench and field conduct

Rule 3 sec 3 pg 28

(first team warning – second ejection)

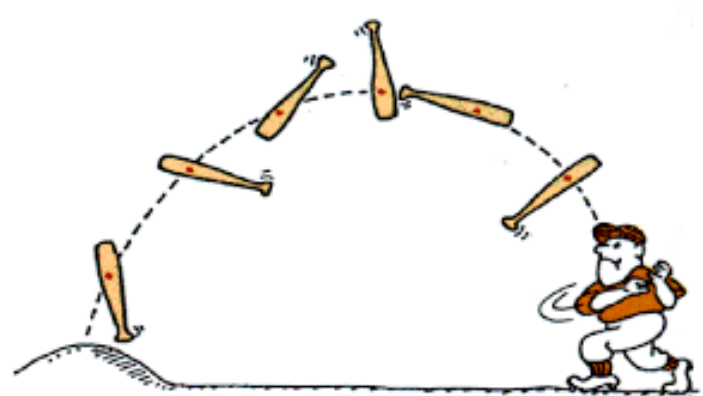
Leaving dugout during live ball;

Fake tag without the ball; also is obstruction

Carelessly throw a bat

Wears jewelery

Hit ball to players after game has started



Rule 3 sec 3.F pg 28

Unsportsmanlike acts -- ejected – unless deemed minor then a warning can be issued (bench restriction for player is not an option)



1) Insightful words 2) profanity / baiting 3) intimidating 4) non in spirit of good play 5) being in live ball during opponents infield practice prior to game start 6) member of staff (other than head coach leaving dugout or coaching box to dispute a call) 7) unsportsmanlike conduct toward umpires until the umpires have departed the game site

For 6 – both head and coach restricted or ejected – depending

Rule 3 sec 3.G,H,I,j,K

More actions - shall not --- -- ejected – unless deemed minor then a warning can be issued (bench restriction for player is not an option)

g. Enter area behind catcher while pitcher and catcher in position h. coach with objects other than stopwatch, rulebook, scorebook i. Outside bench area or bullpen j. charge an umpire; k. Use amplifier or bullhorns during game.



Rule 3 sec 3 art 1 l,m,n,o,p

More actions - shall not --- -- penalty ejection – warning not offered as option

l. Deliberately throw bat or helmet m. malicious contact offense or defense; n. Call “time” or other act for the purpose of causing a balk o. use tobacco or tobacco-like productions within confines of field p. Leave positions or bench during fight or physical altercation (watch and make number notes)

M – ball dead immediately p. coach can help prevent or stop

Rule 3 sec 3 art 2 ejected coach must leave vicinity of playing area - avoid contact with team – may return to attend to injured or ill player

Rule 3 sec 3 art 3 - player warming up - shall remain in the area of their team's on deck circle - penalty team warning – then ejection

Rule 3 sec 3 art 4 - situation – loosening up in area not protected by fence – another member of the team with a glove must position between them and batter to protect - don't interfere with live ball
