2014 CTYLA RULE CHE...	

1. Scheduling Issues

- A. General update
- B. Field name issues
- B. Some teams with imbalanced number of games
- D. Coach contact info
- C. Feedback from associations

- Programs that had scheduled games before 1230p on Sunday were adjusted to 1230p based on league agreement that no games would start before 1230p
- Teams that scheduled games with Regan reported game as their HOME game (both Regan and opposing team both reported they were playing at HOME). Those teams need to coordinate with Reagan and determine who is the home team and notify Derek.
- Short/extra games - some teams are scheduled less than 8 games or more than 8 games - check your schedule. If you are a team that is short a game then you will need to find an opponent and submit a game change request.
- Some programs need to enter field information, do not worry about entering blackout dates. Set field availability dates to large window (i.e. 2/22-5/11)
- ★◦ **IMPORTANT:** If you show a field conflict on your schedule in MyLacrosseLeague then you will need to get those resolved ASAP. - Referees cannot be scheduled until field conflicts are resolved
- Programs need to enter their coaches contact information in MyLacrosseLeague.com.
- All affiliates should have received login information - if you do not have login information then contact Jason Isaac or Derek Craig.
- "Coaches conflict" on the schedule - This is an indicator that two coaches are scheduled at the same time. Should be resolved at a program level. Coaches conflict does not impact ability for league to schedule games or referees

2. Final rules "cheat sheet" has been sent out with this Agenda

- Officials will use cheat sheet as reference during games when clarifying CTYLA rules

3. Set CTYLA policy and procedure on sending out camp/clinic info

- Message board on www.ctyla.org for posting camps/clinics.
- CTYLA will not send any notifications out about activities in the area. Reference message board.

4. Stress that the CTYLA website ctyla.org is the place to look for info, not emails - website is place to look for latest info. Website is keep up to date.

5. End of year Senior Red Tournament proposal to split teams in pools
 - A. Number of games
 - B. Dates 4/26 - 4/27
 - C. Location proposed 5 Mile Dam Park, Kyle Tx
 - D. Main issue - field costs; Should CTYLA approach potential sponsors? Is there a trainer that would donate time?
- Red structure is still a work in progress - Details are still being worked.
 - Initial 6 games determine pool structure based on win/loss
 - April 26/27 - suggested as tournament weekend at a central location.
 - Feedback during meeting
 - Refs available? - April 26/27 High School refs should be available unless they are on a team that is in the HS playoffs
 - Slide one week out? - weekend of May 4/5 would create 3 week gap between game #6 and the tournament (due to no games schedule on Easter weekend)
- Cost - security and on-site trainer required by 5 Mile Dam Park, cost is ~\$3,000 (includes trainer and security paid by the park). Field rental is \$1,500.
 - CTYLA is looking for other options for a trainer and security personnel
 - ? ▪ Is there any association that could donate a trainer to help offset the cost?
 - Would we be willing to take a sponsor for the tournament? - consensus is that is a great idea. No objections voiced.
 -  **AI Rich:** Will search for options to fund the cost of the tournament.
 - ★ ◦ **Motion:** Have tournament at central location for RED level teams. No cost to teams - Motion Approved.
