PLAYER'S WAIVER AND CONSENT

WARRANTY PLAYER'S FITNESS

The undersigned (hereinafter, "the Player") hereby warrants to the Canadian National Oldtimers' Baseball Federation (hereinafter, "the Federation") that he is thirty-three (33), forty-three (43), fifty (50), sixty (60), and seventy (70) years of age or over as of December 31 of this tournament year, is in good physical condition, and that he has no impairment or ailment preventing him from engaging in the activities of the Federation.

PLAYER'S PARTICIPATION IN PROVINCIAL TOURNAMENTS AND LOCAL LEAGUES

As a member of the Federation, the Player shall be eligible to participate in the Federation National Tournament, as organized by the host team and the Federation, according to the regulations officially announced by the Federation.

The Player recognizes as a member of this Federation, the authority of the President, Commissioner, Vice President, Treasurer and Convener / Conveners of the Tournament to determine and enforce organizational policy.

The Player agrees to abide by all rules and regulations as set forth by the Tournament Rules and the Federation Constitution. Failure to abide by all rules and regulations could result in suspension or expulsion, and possible forfeit of all games in which rules and regulations were not followed.

VOLUNTARY ASSUMPTION OF RISK

The Player shall participate in the Federation's programs and/or use of any Federation's facilities, services, or equipment at his own risk. The Player waives any and all claims, of whatsoever kind or nature, that may arise against the Federation as a result of the Player's participation in the local leagues, provincial tournaments, or Federation recreational baseball program. The Player also acknowledges recognition of the Federation rules and any deviation from helmet requirements (all batters and runners must always wear certified batting helmets and catchers are to wear protective head gear) is at his own risk. The Player also acknowledges recognition of the fact that neither medical insurance nor liability insurance is inherent with national membership.

ABSOLUTE RELEASE OF LIABILITY

In consideration of being permitted to participate in the activities of the Federation, in any manner, including but not limited to playing, practicing, coaching, spectating, or being on the field or in spectator areas for any purpose whatsoever, and fully understanding that participation in the game of baseball includes the risk of serious personal injury, the undersigned Player fully and absolutely assumes full responsibility for the risk of injury due to participation, weather conditions, playing conditions (including the types of bases, plates, fences and equipment), other participants, of any magnitude including fatality, and does hereby forever absolutely release and agrees to hold harmless the Federation, all government bodies and landlords that may sanction or permit the participation in the game of baseball and all employees, other participants, agents, servants, officers, public officials, volunteers, game officials and sponsors from all claims for damage whatsoever of any kind now or in the future.
