Tournament Drop Out Fees

 Motion was brought forth by Bethel to increase the penalty for teams that sign up for the Mid-Season or End of Season Tournaments and then drop out. The proposed penalty to increase the team fine from \$50 up to \$100 and the head coach from that team would be placed on 1 year probation. If the team drops out a 2nd time while the coach is on probation, that head coach would be suspended from the league for 1 year. Motion was supported by Mt. Orab.
