IV. Proposed Rule Changes

- 1. 12u and 14u moved down to 12 game season.
 - a. 3-4 teams affected by club ball.
 - b. Many teams only got 8-9 games in last year.
 - c. 10 votes for a "YES" to this change.
- 2. 24 hour cooldown period for coaches after an incident or argument during a game.
 - a. Discussed and decided no changes.
- 3. Set Cutoff dates for make-up games.
 - a. Discussed 5 days to provide make-up date
 - b. After 2 weeks, reps set a date for the game.
 - c. 9 votes for a "YES"
- 4. Age adjustment to include grade appropriate players.
 - a. This way a kid can play with their grade level.
 - b. Example: "5U or Kindergarten"
 - c. Would only affect very few kids, those held back or start late.
 - d. Case by case basis.
 - e. 8 votes for "YES" on a case by case basis.
- 5. Mid-season tournament will be split to 2 random draw brackets for any division with 8 or more teams. End of Season tournament will be a straight double elimination bracket based on seeding.
 - a. over 8 teams has a Gold/Silver bracket
 - b. discussion of medals over t-shirts for mid-season tournament
 - c. 10 votes for "YES"
