**Read all rules and regulations prior to signing-up. Select correct boy or girl module & current grade.**

**If your child's grade is not available contact the office to be added to a wait list, registering in an incorrect grade will not guarantee acceptance.**

**Eligibility:** Children attending a BAPS school are eligible, those living in the BAPS district and attending a school outside of BA must be approved prior to registration. **1<sup>st</sup>/7<sup>th</sup> girl's teams & 1<sup>st</sup>/10<sup>th</sup> boy's teams**, 8-9-10<sup>th</sup> graders trying out for your school team, **MUST** register during normal registration to guarantee availability. 6<sup>th</sup>-10<sup>th</sup> graders may not play rec ball while also playing on a school team. *Eligibility subject to verification. Birth Certificate to be on file—coach will collect. Email replies should be received, one as receipt of registration--the other a payment link.*

**Cost: First Child \$160, Second Child \$150, Third Child \$110;** to receive family discount note siblings on each registrations and modify the payment amount accordingly during checkout. **Minimum payment at time of registration is \$55 (registration will not go thru without payment).** Balance due Dec 1. A late fee of \$20 will be added & must be paid by cash/check only. All credit card pmts done online thru the email link received at time of registration, cash/check drop off/mailed to BAABA **NO REFUNDS AFTER DRAFTS ARE HELD. Refund if approved is subject to fees. NO FUNDRAISER! NO PLAYER WITH A REMAINING BALANCE (from previous seasons) WILL BE ACCEPTED UNTIL DELINQUENT AMOUNT PAID IN FULL & current season's minimum balance paid**

Held at the office building. (All players receive NEW uniform as they will be different)

**Gate:** charged at all venues \$4 adult and \$1 students and senior citizens (fee set by INBC)

**Jewelry:** NO jewelry, this includes pierced earrings! Exceptions are not made because the piercing is new.

**Developmental League:** We use a draft system to form teams, **NO** player maybe added to a team except thru the draft process.

**INBC protect rule:** returning team's 1 protect & new team's 4 protects; must be **new players** to the INBC.

**COMBINE--Practice: All players subject to the draft will attend a combine practice, 10/21 at the BACC on Main St (date, times, to be confirmed).. approximately an hour in the afternoon, watch the website for posting of the specific times it should be available Wed-Thur of that week, those not attending will be subject to a blind draft and be drawn to teams. If your child is new to the league, or will not be returning with last year's team they must attend to be available for the coaches to 'select' them at the draft, those not attending will be placed by the league.** Players do not attend the draft, just the combine practice.

**Notice of Team Affiliation:** You should hear from your coach after November 1st,

**Start of Season: tentative dates only at this time:**

**Practice: Rec teams will begin approximate Oct 29-(modified time that week)** Minimum of 1 hour possibly 1 & hour and a half depending on availability of gyms. We strive to give ½ court practices as a rule. Please be on time not too early or late & leave on time.

Practice: We only practice thru the week, practice times vary, and obviously we give the youngest the 6:00-7:30pm and fill from there. Practices should end by 9:00pm at the latest. What day you would get depends on coach's availability and gym availability.

Wednesday's are only allowed when 100% of the parents agree. At this time we can not specify a day/time. Practices are scheduled a month at a time.

**Games:** approximately 8-9 games determined by INBC. Tentative schedule, starts week of Dec 7 we will play 2 weeks then break resuming January 4, thru first of March depending on weather. Most games will be on Saturday; however some may be thru the week i.e. BAABA uses Friday night as well. Select games are more so thru the week. INBC tourney follows end of season approximately Feb 19 thru Mar 2, championship Saturday.

**Gyms:** Home games (about 50%) held BA Community center. Games will also be scheduled at other leagues gym sites.

**Goals:** 1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup>—8.6 ft; 3<sup>rd</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> 10 ft.

**Balls:** 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup>—27.5; 3<sup>rd</sup>-6<sup>th</sup>& 7/8<sup>th</sup> girls—28.5 (women's); 7-10<sup>th</sup> boys men's ball. Game balls provided on game day.

**Additional Costs:** Practice ball, shoes, cost of travel to practices and games & gate fee at all games.
