



Return to Play Guidelines

(Supplement to Baseball NL Guidelines)

- Washrooms are to be locked and not used except for the Skills and Drills program on Team Gushue. Workers will accompany each player and unlock the washrooms and re-lock the door after use. Washrooms will be cleaned at the end of the day.
- No Bleachers will be used. This is a directive from the City.
- Where available, players for each team will enter and leave through separate gates
- Players will not be permitted in dugouts. They will line up on the 1st and 3rd Base lines where physical distance markers will be spray painted on the bottom of the fence.
- Hand Sanitizer and disinfectant wipes will be made available in the dugouts, gloves and masks will be made available to coaches in case of tending to an injured player.
- Only two catchers will be permitted for each team per game. We will have two sets of gear available for each team per game and sanitize them between games. All other equipment is brought by the players. Umpires equipment will be sanitized after each game.
- T-Ball groups will consist of one parent and one child on the field in maximum groups of 20 (i.e. 8 players, 8 parents and 2 workers).
- Team sizes will be reduced in Novice, Rookie, Mosquito and Pewee to 12 players instead of 15.
- All players are required to bring their own helmets, gloves and **bats**. No sharing of equipment is allowed. T-Ball players will be supplied bats and they will be sanitized after each session.
- Games times will be schedule 30 minutes from finish to start to allow players to vacate the field.
- Canteens will not be permitted.
- All workers will be trained to adhere to the guidelines.
- Emails will be sent out weekly to the league parents to promote our physical distancing measures.
