



## QUICK GUIDE



### LEAGUE CHARTERING DOCUMENTATION

(refer to the latest Babe Ruth League, Inc. Rules & Regulations for detailed explanations and approved rulings)

**Proof of Birth Date** (0.04, paragraph 1) – Players must present to the league president before the first local scheduled game, an Original Record of Birth or a certified copy of an original record of birth. Such record of birth must be one of the following documents:

1. Certificated from any one of a number of agencies listed under rule 0.04, para.1a.
2. Official laminated ID or electronic ID cards
3. A Babe Ruth Leagues, Inc. letter of waiver
4. A certified copy of Delayed Registration of Birth from an approved agency (0.04, paragraph 1b)
5. Notification of Birth Registration from various agencies (0.04, paragraph 1c)

**Difficulty with obtaining records** (0.04, paragraph 2) – If there is difficulty complying with birth certification requirements a league, state organization, parent or guardian may contact Babe Ruth Leagues, Inc. directly regarding a Letter of Waiver prior to the player's first scheduled game. If this situation exists, it must be taken care of immediately upon a player's entrance into the Babe Ruth League.

**Team Rosters & League Schedule** (0.04, paragraph 3) – Team rosters and a league schedule shall be filed and recorded in the SI-Play System with Babe Ruth Leagues, Inc. on or before the league's first regularly scheduled game.

- Faxed or emailed rosters will NOT be accepted.
- To be eligible to participate in tournament play, a player, manager, or coach must be listed on the local league regular season rosters and on a tournament rosters before competing in the first level of tournament play.

**League Insurance** (0.01, paragraph 6) – Leagues that use third party insurance must show \$1,000,000 liability coverage for sexual abuse and molestation coverage.

**Coaching Certification & Background Check** (0.04, paragraph 4) – Rostered Managers and coaches in all divisions are required to complete Coaching Registration and Certification, a nationwide background check, and Abuse Prevention Training in accordance with the Safe Sports Act.

- **Background Check** (0.01, paragraph 7) – Once a volunteer has successfully completed and passed background screening, it is valid for a two (2) year period.
