Playoff Seeding Determination

Top four seeds will make the playoffs in each division. The one seeds will play the four seeds and the two seeds will play the three seeds in the semi-final round. The winners will be paired to play in the championship game.

Seeding is determined by:

- 1. Overall record
- 2. Head-to-Head (if two are tied)
- 3. Points Against
- 4. Strength of Schedule

Strength of Schedule is to be calculated by creating a cumulative total of the Winning Percentage for all the opponents that a team has beaten during the regular season.

* In the event that an age group has an odd number of teams and plays outside opponents, NTFA reserves the right to remove that game from the standings. If this causes other NTFA teams to have more games in the standings. The NTFA board reserve the right to randomly draw a game played between two NTFA teams that played each other multiple times during the season and remove one of those games from the standings for an equal number of games played between all teams in a division.
