As a participant of our AAU program, both player and parent(s)/guardian(s) must adhere to the following codes of conduct:

Player Code of Conduct

- It is my responsibility to attend all practices, training sessions, games, etc. I will be on time and prepared, unless proper notification has been given to the head coach. Failure to do so, could lead to a reduction of playing time.
- I will accept my role as a member of this team. The role will be clearly defined by the head coach, and it will be my responsibility to carry out the role, to the best of my ability.
- I will show respect to all coaches, game officials, teammates and opposing players and fans at all times. I will never act in a manner that is disrespectful, or embarrassing to team, school, or program.
- I will demonstrate good sportsmanship, regardless of the score or situation, by acting in a positive manner towards coaches, officials, players, and fans.
- I will display good sportsmanship and commitment to my team at all times.
- I will compete and challenge my teammates, daily. It is my job to make my teammates, as well as myself better, everyday.
- I will refrain from any negative comments or reactions via social media. Any post towards OTP or Clovis High School, or its basketball program, players, coaches, parents, fans, or opponents will be positive, and of good taste. Failure to do so will result in disciplinary action set by the director of OTP.

Parent/Guardian Code of Conduct

- I (and my guests) will be a positive role model for my child and encourage sportsmanship by showing respect and courtesy, and by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, officials, and spectators at every game or practice.
- I (and my guests) will not engage in any kind of unsportsmanlike conduct with any officials, coach, player, parent, or spectator, such as: booing, taunting, or using profane language or gestures.
- I will not encourage any behaviors or practices that would endanger the health and well-being of athletes.
- I will demand that my child treat opposing players and coaches, officials, and spectators with respect at all times, regardless of race, creed, color, sex, or ability.
- I will never ridicule or yell at my child or other participants for making mistakes or losing a competition.
- I will respect all officials and coaches for their authority during games and practices. I will never question, discuss, or confront officials or coaches at the gymnasium. I will agree to meet at an agreed-upon time and place, with any concerns or questions I may have.
- I will refrain from coaching my child or other players during games and practices, unless I am one of the registered coaches for the team.

By signing this contract, the player and parent(s)/guardian(s) both provide consent that a player who violates the **Code of Conduct** may be subject to disciplinary action set by **Old Town Pride, B.C.**, and by the team's head coach. Disciplinary actions may include reduced playing time, temporary suspension from practices/games, and or termination from the program, if warranted.
