In 2019, the Patriots opted out of the "C" (i.e. Barkan Division) semifinal playoffs after losing Game 1 and playing to a 10-10 tie in Game 2 (recorded in the table above as a playoff loss).										
<sup>3</sup> In 2019 the Gray Rocks won Game 1 of the semifinal round against the Patriots and tied at 10-10 for Game 2. The Patriots opted not to complete the game and to drop out of the semifinals so, for the purpose of this record, the win for Game 2 was awarded to the Gray Rocks.										
NOTES:										
- No Regular season records were kept in 2004, 2005, and 2006. There was a single Playoff game in 2004 - Gray Rocks won v. Pirates.										
- Most PWBL (Philadelphia Women's Baseball League) games were against pick-up 55+ teams.										
- Tri-State put a volunteer team in the S J League in 2007. They were 2-18-1.										
- In 2016, playoffs for "C" and "D" Divisions were suspended after the "C" Division semi-finals in favor of a recreational round robin.										
- In 2017, the 55+ teams split into two Divisions (Anderson and Unthank) as described in the History of the League document.										
- For 2018-2021, the 55+ teams split into named Divisions for the playoffs (1st-4th - Anderson; 5th-8th - Unthank; 9th-xxth - Barkan) instead of "A", "B", and "C" Divisions										
- No games were played in 2020 due to the COVID-19 pandemic
