

ABOUT THE COACH



Gene Stechschulte is in his sixth season as the Head Coach at ONU. Prior to coming to ONU Gene was memeber of the St. Louis Cardinals. He played collegiately at Ashland University where he was an All-American and graduated first in his class in 1996.

Since taking over the ONU Baseball Program, Gene has had tremendous success. He inherited a team that was the worst team in the leauge the year prior. He has since turned the program into a winning stable. The Polar Bears have a record of 79-37 in the past three seasons, finishing in the top half of the Ohio Athletic Conference each year. Lead by the pitching staff ONU has garnered national attention after being ranked to start the 2016 season. ONU pitching has recorded some of the best numbers in the country. All-American sophomore TJ Storer finished second in Division III for earned run average.

Gene has had offeres to coach teams all across the country but is coaching at ONU for one reason. ONU provides opportunities to its students that other universities do not.
