Please do not park on Commissioners Road. Any car parked on this road is subject to a parking ticket. ***It's recommended to use the Shop Rite parking lot as overflow parking if needed. We recommend sending the parking information to your parents as parking is tight every year.***

MVPs

Game MVPs for each team should be selected by the opposing coaches and announced when the teams are lined up and ready to shake hands. If possible, please have a new MVP for each game as we would like to see as many kids receive MVP medals as possible. Please indicate your MVPs on the Game Slip as we will announce them on Twitter and our website.

Game Balls:

- Two new Game Balls will be supplied for every game, provided the teams retrieve foul balls and get them back to the umpire. If for some reason you need additional Game Balls please contact the noted on-site Tournament Contacts above.
- If a player hits a home run, the player is welcome to keep the ball if the Team replaces it with a quality baseball that can be used in the tournament game.

Sportsmanship:

Unfortunately, negative behavior and bad sportsmanship at youth sporting events has become a major issue across our country. Baseball tournaments are not immune to this and in some instance may spur more of it as it is tournament play. Please remember that the games are for the kids, not the adults, and we expect every coach, parent, fan and all adults to set a positive example for the players through their words and actions.

Everyone that attends the tournament is expected to act in a positive manner, no matter the outcome of a play, call by an umpire or the game itself. We encourage you to forward this to your parents and fans. We simply ask the following:

- **Let the Players play**
- **Let the Coaches coach**
- **Let the Umpires umpire**

Any coach or parent who is ejected from a game by an umpire is considered ejected from the tournament and is not to return to the complex for the duration of the tournament.
