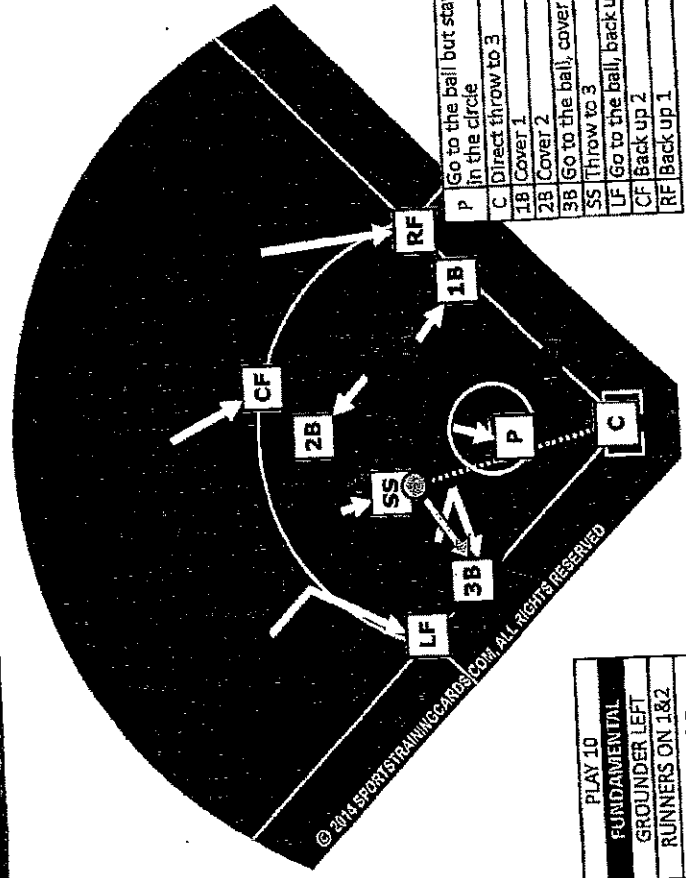

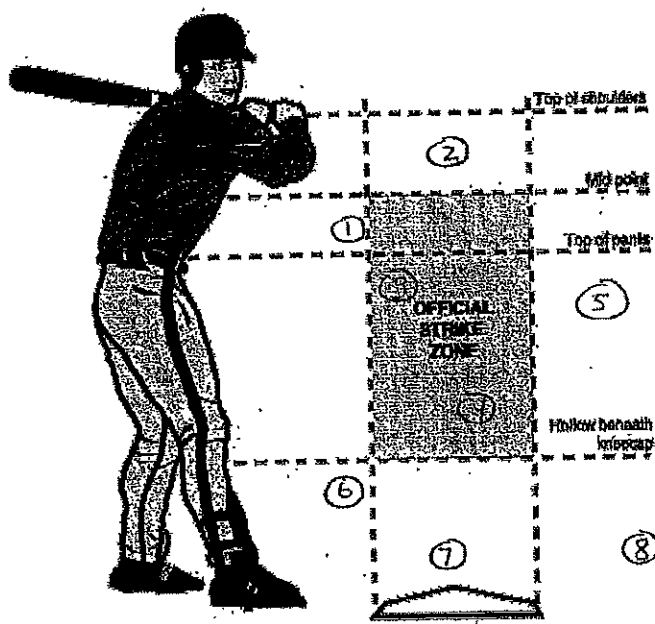
- Ⓐ covering 2B

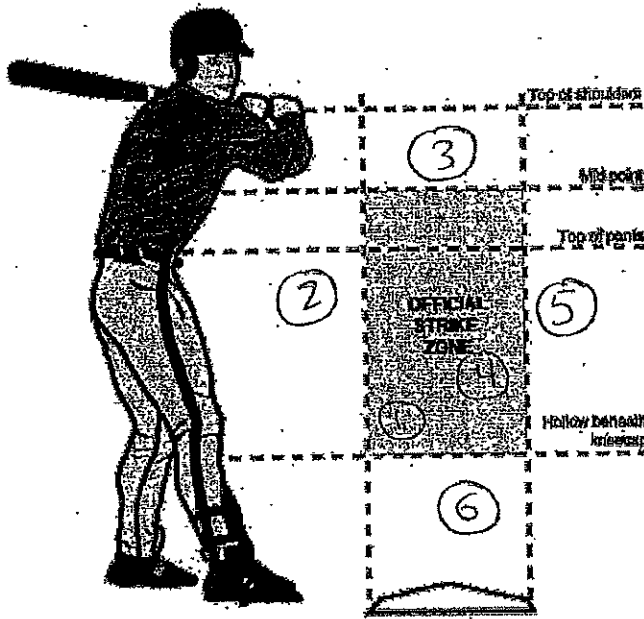

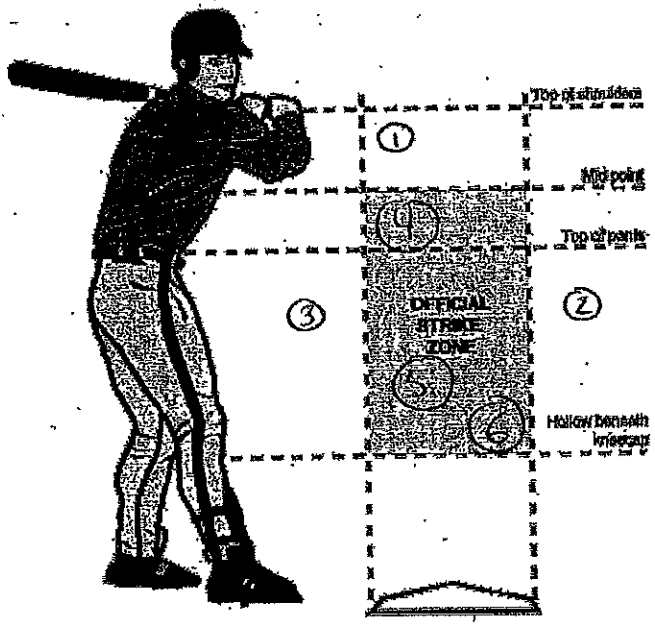

Notes:

(A) 3 pitched balls inside the strike zone or the batter swings and misses a pitched ball = Strike out

(B) The batter goes back to the bench when Strike out occurs
