

U9/U11 Buildout Line Enforcement

Buildout Line (BOL) is used to promote the ball being played out of the back in a less pressured setting.

- When goalkeeper has the ball, either during play (from the opponent) or from a goal kick, the opposing team must move behind the BOL
- Once opposing team is retreating towards the BOL, the goalkeeper can pass, throw, or roll the ball to a teammate (NO PUNTING)
- **Once ball has been touched by a teammate (by either rolling or passing) then the opposing team can cross the BOL and play resumes as normal once defending team has touched the ball.**
- Allows for offside offenses to be called

Marking Buildout Lines

- Paint lines directly of the field
- Use four cones (two on each side) to indicate the lines
