What's the Call Ump? Brendan hits a gapper and is going for two. As he approaches 2<sup>nd</sup> base he is obstructed by the 2<sup>nd</sup> base person. The throw from the outfield gets away from the shortstop. Brendan picks himself up and heads for 3<sup>rd</sup> where he is thrown out.

In the ump's judgment Brendan would have been safe at 2<sup>nd</sup> and no further had the obstruction not occurred, but he forfeited this protection when he tried to advance to 3<sup>rd</sup>. Therefore he is out at 3<sup>rd</sup> and the obstruction is nullified. (Rule 8, Section 5, B3)

If the obstructed runner is put out after passing the base which would have been reached had there been no obstruction or advanced beyond the two bases where the obstruction occurred. Effect: a The ball remains live. b The obstructed runner is called out.
