

To Access the Livestream of Sunday Worship and Wednesday Bible Study – LIVE (as it is happening)

The following instructions explain the easiest and least confusing way to access the livestream of our Sunday Morning Worship Service and Wednesday Night Bible Study (or any livestream we may happen to do.)

The first step is to determine the device you are going to view the livestream on. The reason for this is to easily access the livestream, you will get one of two views initially – traditional or mobile. If you are not sure, just read through these instructions and you will be able to determine the view, traditional or mobile, based on the screen shots.

*****NOTE: For those who are more technically savvy, there are instructions at the end as to how to access the livestream directly from YouTube in case you are using a smart TV or choose to go straight to YouTube.**

Here are a few things to keep in mind to help make your livestream experience the best it can be:

- Adjust the volume on your device to what sounds best for you. The recording sound varies based on several factors. All of these have to be taken into consideration. This means you may have to adjust it up or down during the stream if speakers, singers, videos, presentations, etc. change. For now, we do not have the live stream connected to a sound board; thus, we have it set to accommodate a range of factors.
- There is a 7-9 second delay in transmission. (I lovingly refer to this as the “wardrobe malfunction delay.” This was put into many livestreams in the event “something” happened in real time that really should not be transmitted live. Unfortunately, in today’s world, it is necessary.)
- The livestream will start approximately 10-12 minutes before service/study begins. You may see no one on stage or just hear background noise until the event starts. This is okay. After the event has concluded and been published, we will edit the video and remove the “dead” space.
- Thank you for your patience with us as we go through this process. This is new and we are still learning many aspects and will learn a new process when we move into the sanctuary. We are excited to bring you this feature and look forward to expanding our capabilities.

In the traditional view, the church's website will open and appear similar to this (note: there are 5 scrolling photos so the photo may be different but the layout will be the same.)




At the top (see arrow above) the 4th icon from the left is




Click on the  icon (it is actually the YouTube icon.)

The first video in the list should look similar to this:




You will be looking for the red box and the "live now" If you log in real early, it may be displaying:


MOBILE VIEW




DIRECT YOUTUBE SEARCH

The fastest way to find the church's YouTube channel is:


- Open a web browser/search engine




- Search for “Cedar Falls Baptist Church YouTube”
