Both had great worship services, got back in time to eat lunch, observe the baptism of 20 people and go out to visit two Bible Clubs and fellowship with a group of ladies who very happy to receive a small love gift the ladies helped make.

How great is our God?! As we reflect back on 2012, we have seen MANY blessings in many lives. It has been a time of good-byes as Toby and his family moved back to the US, Jonathan's adoption was finalized, we have seen more of God's miracles, we purchased the 'new to us' bus, Over 300 people have gone through the baptismal pool, funds are being raised for the Salaga Area Ministry Center, along with three church buildings to be built in 2013, and the number of Bible Club children soared to over 9,100. **How GREAT is our God!** Have a Blessed 2013.
