The questions we use to teach the children in Bible Clubs is translated to Dagbani and the Leaders help the children learn.

Rallies are organized for both Zonal and Regional rallies every year for Bible quizzes to assess their learning ability of the Word of God. The clubs are doing wonderful when visited.

Our prayer is that the Bible Club ministry teaching the children the Bible, praise songs and games will help the churches to grow.



### **Paul Abukari — Nyankpala Area**

The Bible Club ministry has revived some churches in our areas. With the help of teams from U.S.A, we have three villages working on new Bible Clubs, Galenshegu, Gua and Kpendua.

Each club I visit four times a year, two visits to the club and two visits to the leaders. I do this to encourage the leaders and the children. I also give toffees to the children.

### **Thomas Saaka — Tamale Area**

Every Bible Club Leader first goes through Foundation training to learn ways to present the Gospel to children.

We have zonal leaders to help oversee the clubs and to visit and encourage the clubs. They volunteer to do this so we give them money for their petrol and a small appreciation for their hard work.

### **Matthew Zeblim — Gushegu Area**

It is our God that has called us to sow the seeds of the Gospel. Gushegu is a large area that needs more attention. Not many churches have gone there. We hope and pray that the Lord will use Seed Ministry to cover all the villages to receive Him and make Him known, so many children and their families will be saved.
