Pastor Abraham, who has been one of our ministry partners ever since we have been in Ghana and is one of our very best friends, has informed us that they now have another BOY that was born September 13 at 9am! Len had the privilege of preaching at the 'outdooring' which is the baby naming ceremony. I've always thought this is such a way to welcome a new child into the home. Instead of a baby shower before the baby comes, everyone comes to this ceremony as the mother and baby (both dressed in white) are presented to the guests. A Pastor shares the Word and a special time of prayer follows for the family. The 'gifts' consist of an offering being taken so the parents are given the money to buy what they need.

Of course those needs are quite different than what our baby 'needs' are. There is no Nursery to worry about painting. Baby sleeps in a small bed beside his parents. Bottles, formula and sterilizer are not used. Toys consist of one or two instead of a myriad of them. What they have in common with us is LOVE for their child and this is such a special way of introducing their child to the ones they love the most.

Matthew Ziblim - Gushegu Area Leader

Matthew shared with Len that when he and Pastor Jacob went to Gushegu in 2000 to show the Jesus Film, there were NO churches. Now there are 10 but they are young and weak.

In addition to his role as Seed Ministry Gushegu Outpost Area Leader, Matthew is a school teacher for another organization, preaches, does Evangelism through the Jesus Film Crusades, and mentors about 5 young men. All of this in addition to being a husband and father. Please pray for him as often as you think of him.
