Memorials To Remember

God, in His great wisdom, knew that we would have trouble with our memory and that important things would slip our minds. As time passes we lose track of events that have happened and we sometimes forget important information to help us along in life. Many times in the Bible God refers to memorials to be erected or established so the people would not forget. God even refers to some memorials to remember Him specifically so that we would not forget who He is.

God wants us to remember His name and He tells Moses to tell the people that "I Am" sent him. And then in Ex. 3:15 God tells Moses "... This is My name forever, and this is My memorial-name to all generations." You can see David understood too that we are to remember the Lord always when you read Psalm 135:13 and Psalm 102:12. We are to never forget the name of God.

God wants us to remember His mighty power. When He delivered the Israelites from their slavery to Egypt, He proclaimed in Ex. 12:14 "*Now this day will be a memorial to you...*" And this day, Passover, is still celebrated today.

For those same people of the Old Testament He instituted a memorial to let them know that He would remember them. "And you shall put the two stones on the shoulder pieces of the ephod, as stones of memorial for the sons of Israel, and Aaron shall bear their names before the Lord on his two shoulders for a memorial." (Ex. 28:12)

As long as we do not begin to worship anyone other than Him, God is approving of memorials for people also. Mary of Bethany poured a very expensive and precious ointment on Jesus' head. And for this sacrificial act, Mary was given this commendation from Christ, "Truly I say to you, wherever this gospel is preached in the whole world, what this woman has done shall also be spoken of in memory of her." (Matt. 26:13)

As we serve the Lord, we sometimes lose sight of the fact that our treasures are to be stored up in heaven. So, let me give you this last nugget to hold on to. We are told about a man named Cornelius in the book of Acts. Acts 10:2 tells us this about Cornelius, "A devout man, and one who feared God with all his household, and gave many alms to the Jewish people, and prayed to God continually." An angel of God came to Cornelius with this message, "... Your prayers and alms have ascended as a memorial before God." (Acts 10:4) May we humbly see and even gain strength from the fact that God memorializes those who dedicate to prayer and outwardly serve Him.

Each day, as we Christians rise up in the morning, may we treat the day as a Memorial Day and remember the love of God and the love of His Son for us. In all the hustle and bustle of life let us not forget what has been done for us so we may one day see the King and we will be forever in His presence where we won't need to be reminded anymore. Until then, may we faithfully serve God, seeking the lost so that their memory will not perish.
