MORNING SESSION

The morning session of the 97th Annual Association began with a worship service. Dr. James Murray, Executive Director of General Baptists, brought the message. Worship service was followed by workshop opportunities. Dr. James Murray and Sam Ramdial, Assistant Director of GB International Missions conducted a workshop on Mission One/Five Year Plan. Rev. Josh Carpenter led the Creative Worship Planning workshop. Rev. Charles Richardson provided training in Building and Leading a ReFocus Team. Rev. Jonathan Rice conducted a workshop on Celebrate Recovery.

LUNCH

Lunch was served by the Rector First General Baptist Church.

AFTERNOON SESSION

The afternoon session began with a memorial presentation of the MoArk Obituary Report. Rev. Bryan Johnson read scripture and led prayer to conclude the memorial service.

Rev. Marston Carpenter called the business meeting of the 97th Association to order. Visitors, Dr. James Murray, Joshua Carpenter, and Sam Ramdial, were welcomed. Then officers were seated.

The moderator presented the written reports to the body. A motion and second was made to accept the reports. Carried.

Oral Reports were given by Sam Ramdial, Donnie Gregory, and Jonathan Rice.

Sam Ramdial reported on Unified Giving, the Missions and Ministry Summit in July, the Mission One Year of Prayer and Fasting Devotional Book which is available by request through the Executive Director's office or may be downloaded from www.gbmissionone.org, the Ministers' Wives' Conference in October, International Missions updates, Faith Home recovery update, Women's Ministries, National Missions, the General Baptist Investment Fund, Stinson Press, the new GB Messenger which will launch at the 2011 Summit, Oakland City University update, Compassionate Care update, and the GB Health care Ministry. Bro. Ramdial concluded his oral presentation with a video of Faith Home. At the conclusion of the video, Rev. Marston Carpenter, 2011 Moderator, presented a check for \$30,225.74 to Sam Ramdial as a gift from the MoArk Association to the Faith Home Mission for repairs to the damages caused by the 2009 earthquake.

Rev. Donnie Gregory gave an oral report from the Arkansas Home Mission Society. He included information about Pedro Rameriz's work in Heber Springs and Clinton. He reported that Ron Byrd has started a

new mission church, Abundant Faith Church, and a new mission church will be started this fall in Flippin, Arkansas.

Rev. Jonathan Rice gave a report on Camp Allen, highlighting the various events that are on this year's calendar.

The moderator received a motion to accept all oral reports. The motion received a second. Carried.

Moderator, Marston Carpenter expressed thanks to the churches of the MoArk Association for all of the Faith Home gifts received. Bro. Carpenter thanked the officers and passed the gavel to the incoming moderator, Rev. James Hamlett. Bro. James Hamlett called for announcements and then closed the 97th Annual meeting of the MoArk Association with prayer.

We are very proud to be a part of the mission work going on in our community with the Open Door Church, with just a hand full of people and the Hand of the Lord. The Home Mission helped organize this Church with Dr. Steven Gray and has continued to support this Church with a \$5,000 grant each year. There are other Churches in our own community, like the Cappadocia Church where we provided funds to replace their Church sign that was blown away in a storm along with the Church. The Arkansas Home Mission is receiving a 2,400 dollar grant each year. Pastor Ron Byrd's Church near Little Rock is also receiving a 2,400 dollar grant each year. Praise the Lord, go look at some of these projects. You will be proud that you had a hand in supporting these Churches. Consider putting the Moark Home Mission Board in your regular budget for 2011 or you may want to take up a Special Offering each year for Home Missions it will go a long ways.

In the area of funding it was decided that our efforts should be focused in the following areas:

MoArk Christian Education Board Report for 2010

The Board met on three separate occasions to discuss our plans for the annual February Seminar and providing workshops for the MoArk Association Meetings and a workshop in the Fall.

We met three times in 2010, June 10th, July 6th, and September 10th, twice in Malden and once in Kennett.

We elected Jeff Smart as President for the 2010-2011 year.

We elected Steve McElwrath as Vice President for the 2010-2011 year.

We re-elected Bryan Johnson as Secretary/Treasurer for the 2010-2011 year.

A follow up report was sent out to the board members and placed online at the MoArk Association Website (www.MoArkGeneralBaptist.org) of our October 2009 Workshop with Tim Gates of New Church Specialties which met at the First General Baptist Church of Rector, AR. It was well attended and the response back was very favorable.

It was decided, however, to go back to our original plan of doing the Annual Seminar in February and therefore, we chose to forego the February 2010 date and plan for February 2011 instead.

We were asked by the MoArk Executive Board to work with the MoArk Association Moderator of 2010, Pastor Charles Richardson on the workshops for the March, 2010 Association but was not needed, as he was well able to handle all the arrangements for them, of which all turned out extremely well.

We discussed different options for needed educational outreaches to our churches and different possible speakers we may bring in for future seminars and workshops. Names, such as Dr. Ed Stetzer, (could not take on any more obligations), Tim Gates (New Church Specialties), Dr. Gary McIntosh (The Church Growth Network), Dr. Stan Toler (Known for Church Leadership and Church Growth and Evangelism and He is Scheduled for February, 2012), Nelson Searcy, John Ed Mathison and Dennis Bickers.

We held a workshop on October 29, 2010 from 7:00 – 9:00 p.m. at the FGBC of Kennett on the subject of Technology in the local church with Todd Luke leading the workshop. It was geared towards those working with technology in the local church and Todd did an excellent job. We are planning on doing a follow up to it in the future.

We have Tim Gates from New Church Specialties doing our February 19, 2011 Seminar focusing on “Understanding and Reaching This Generation” and “Need Oriented Evangelism”.

We have also locked in Dr. Stan Toler to be our February 2012 Seminar Leader but the topic has not be determined as yet.

We hope to offer more opportunities for Christian Education and Church Growth to our local Churches in 2011 than we had in 2010.

We are planning so far a seminar on February 19, 2011 with Tim Gates, A workshop at the March Association Meeting in Rector on a Ministry that reaches out to those with “Hurts and Hangups” and how they can, through Jesus Christ find Recovery, and are considering workshops in June and October as well, if all the plans can come together and we have the interest of our sister churches.

MOARK ASSOCIATION RESOLUTIONS

1. Be it resolved that we ask each church to pay out of its treasury \$6.00 per member association dues for its total attendance and that the Clerk send a letter of reminder that the churches have their reports, dues and \$20.00 for meals sent in before the first week in March. In that letter the Association Clerk will advise the various Church Clerks where this money shall be sent. Any church desiring the Association or Presbytery should make that request in writing to the Association Clerk.
2. Be it resolved that the printing of the Association minutes will be at the discretion of the Executive Board regarding number and format, in order to improve efficiency.
3. Be it resolved that we pay the Associational Clerk/Treasurer \$800.00 for his/her services.
4. Be it resolved that we encourage all churches in the MoArk Association to contribute 2% of church income to Camp Allen (if at all possible). This is to be sent to Junior Burnett, HC 1 Box 1590, Greenville, MO 63944.
5. Be it resolved that we encourage each church to pay all or at least one-half of the tuition for each camper attending Camp Allen.
6. Be it resolved that we encourage each church to invite a representative from Oakland City University to come and share their college activities.
7. Be it resolved that we give our host church a standing vote of thanks for their splendid work in entertaining the Association, and that the Moderator name the host church.
8. Be it resolved that we give the officers and all who participate in today's program a standing vote of thanks for their faithful service.
9. Be it resolved that the delegation of each church bring to their church leaders or church business meeting a request to support Moark Home Missions with 2% of church income (if at all possible). Send contributions to Joyce Hughes, 18979 State Highway J, Malden, MO 63863.
10. Be it resolved that our minute books be printed and ready to use by the Fall setting of the Presbytery.
11. Be it resolved that we encourage all churches in the Moark Association to use Stinson Press for all Literature purchases and printing needs, if cost effective.
12. Be it resolved that we recommend that our MoArk churches become involved in a "Mission Blitz" ministry in each church's community.
13. Be it resolved that the presiding moderator of the Association will be the alternate delegate for the Council of Association MoArk representatives, and the presiding vice moderator of the Association will be the alternate delegate for the Camp Allen Board MoArk representatives.

CONSTITUTION OF MOARK ASSOCIATION

1. This association, when properly organized, shall have a moderator, vice moderator and clerk/treasurer, who shall be chosen by vote of the members present. The duty of the moderator shall be to keep the association in order, state questions fairly, and take the vote; to have liberty of speech as other members provided his seat be filled; to have no vote unless the members be equally divided in which case, he shall have the deciding vote. The duty of the vice moderator shall be to serve as moderator, automatically, if for any reason the moderator is unable to serve. The duty of the clerk/treasurer shall be to keep a fair and accurate record of all proceedings of the association and to take care of all association monies for which he/she is assigned responsibility and to give an annual report. A second vice moderator shall be elected along with the other officers to become vice moderator at the end of the session.
2. This association shall be composed of all ordained persons and such delegates as shall be chosen from the churches to represent them in the association.
3. Each church shall be entitled to three (3) delegates. A quorum shall consist of the delegates representing six (6) or more churches of Moark Association.
4. Letters from the churches sent to the association shall contain the following information: (1) the number of members presently in fellowship, (2) the number received, (3) the number baptized, (4) the number dismissed, (5) and the names of the deceased since the last regular meeting of the association. Other information may be requested by the association.
5. We agree to do all business by vote of the majority of the members present, except in the reception of members, which shall be unanimous. Since the association is made up of churches, the vote of one delegate may not prevent the reception of a church into membership. A majority of the delegates of one church may prevent acceptance of a new member. In case of a negative vote, the association has the right to require that a reason be given. It has the power to determine the validity of that stated reason. The association may override the negative vote if it determines that an injustice is about to be done.
6. This association shall mother a Presbytery consisting of ordained persons of the member churches and we suggest it meet twice a year.
7. We shall receive no church into fellowship with us who has been excluded from any association until the church has made an honest effort to satisfy the offended body.
8. In a situation where a difference arises between two members in a church and the church acts upon it and settles it, further action by the association is prohibited. However, in the event that any party be aggrieved, that party shall have the right to ask permission of the church to bring the matter to the association for settlement.
9. Any member in good standing shall have the right to act as moderator of the association, when elected by the body.
10. Any minister coming from another association and accepting the pastorate of General Baptist church or churches that belong to this association shall at the first regular session of the Presbytery thereafter have his credentials endorsed by said Presbytery, except in case of loss or destruction, in which case the Presbytery may extend time for recovery of credentials or the securing of a reissue from the ordaining Presbytery or some other Presbytery to which the applicant has subsequently belonged. In case of neglect or persistent refusal to comply with the provision, he will be considered out of order and his work rejected.
11. Any church desiring the ordination of a minister must make application to the Presbytery in writing with recommendation of the same.
12. Any church desiring the ordination of a deacon shall make formal request to the Presbytery for its approval. If the Presbytery approves, he may be ordained at that sitting.
13. Each church that represents in the association shall annually pay per member the amount of dues set by this association.
14. This constitution may be altered by a majority vote of three-fourths of the member composing this body. Any member church that becomes dissatisfied with any part of this constitution or with the Statements of Faith shall be entitled to a letter of dismissal.

15. This association will meet annually on Saturday before the fourth Sunday in March at 9:00 a.m. The exception being when Easter falls on the fourth Sunday in March. In this case the Association will meet on the Saturday before the third Sunday in March. (This provision may be changed by a resolution at any sitting of Moark Association.)
16. The Executive Board of the Moark Association of General Baptists shall operate in lieu of the Association when it is not in session to transact business on behalf of the Association. The Association shall have the right to vote on the dissolution of all or substantially all of the assets of the Association and the acquisition of real property and related indebtedness.
17. This body shall be guided by the General Baptist Doctrine and Usage and Worker's Handbook where no rules are found within the framework of this constitution.

2010 COUNCIL OF ASSOCIATIONS (C/A) SUMMARY

**Council of Associations (C/A) Meeting at Oakland City University
May 3, 2010**

The C/A approved the recommendation from the C/A Progress Committee that its time line be extended by one year in light of the executive director transition. The new time line would be:

- The specific structure and program for the self-study be presented to the C/A for affirmation at the May 2011 C/A meeting.
- The committee to carry out the study would be established at the November 2011 C/A meeting.
- The study would begin in January 2012.

Dr. James W. Murray talked about three things necessary in every aspect of our ministry: transparency, responsibility, and accountability. This is a critical time to take a look at our structure and make certain our representation is what we want it to be. He announced that Dr. Stephen Gray, National Missions director, had given his resignation effective at the end of August.

The C/A approved the 2011 budget and will recommend it to the General Association in July.

At the Executive Council meeting, April 6, 2010, a motion was passed that a \$250,000 line of credit be established with General Baptist Investment Fund (GBIF) that could be used in a time of emergency. An emergency is when life and property are in peril. The Executive Committee would determine what would constitute an “emergency” situation. This line of credit will not be used for budget deficits.

The C/A approved that beginning with the 2012 budget; the Budget Committee is to look into ways to set aside reserve funds to fund those things that would constitute an emergency situation.

The C/A ratified the motion passed by the Executive Council to increase the mileage allotment to the government-recommended rate.

Dr. Franklin Dumond reported that the *General Baptist Messenger* publication will be discontinued, as we have known it, after the July 2010 issue. It will become a *Capsule*-type newsletter. In July 2011, with our M&M Summit publication, we will have our first edition of the new *General Baptist Messenger*. This will be a 48-page quarterly piece provided to all known General Baptists, free of charge.

The C/A instructed the Executive Council, through its respective committees, to address the following issues concerning terms of employment: termination of employment and severance packages for all employees of the corporate body.

Council of Associations (C/A) Meeting at Fellowship General Baptist Church November 15, 2010

Interim Executive Director James W. Murray reported on the 5-Year Plan and how prayer changes things. We will spend 6 months next year in prayer and fasting and the next 6 months will be spent in reconciliation. Our best days are ahead of us if we will just pray, fast, become reconciled, and teach people.

Dr. Murray also reported that the consensus is that the International Missions and National Missions Departments will not be combined.

Budget Committee Chairman Russell Collins reported on Unified Giving (UG) for 2010. We are in a better situation than we were a year ago. We will be on target by the end of the year, and the cash flow is in good shape. Spending is being kept within the budget due to the implementation of a process for purchase requests.

Jack Boyer reported that the Personnel Committee is recommending Dr. James W. Murray to be the next Executive Director. The decision to select Dr. Murray was unanimous among the 15 Executive Council members present on the conference call meeting. Dr. Murray stated in the conference call that he would not consider accepting any pay until the obligation to the former executive director is completed. The C/A body approved the recommendation of Dr. James W. Murray to the next setting of the General Association of General Baptists at the Mission & Ministry Summit in July 2011 for election to the office of Executive Director.

At the request of the Social Issues Commission, the C/A will encourage the General Association to form a new board to oversee Compassionate Care and to assign the current members of the Social Issues Commission to that board and then to ask the Nominating Committee of the General Association to nominate people to serve on the Social Issues Commission. This is being requested because the focus of this commission has always been on the work of Compassionate Care.

Dr. Danny Dunivan reported that the National Ordination Standards Commission report is complete. The purpose was to develop criteria that would assist presbyteries, associations, ordaining councils, and churches in maintaining the integrity of ordained ministers. It was recommended that this final document be compiled into a published booklet for use in the denomination.

The C/A approved the recommendation from The Mission & Ministry (M&M) Summit Planning Team that the rates for registration to the M&M Summit be increased to: Preregistration, \$55. Registration on-site, \$65. Block registration, \$400.

General Baptist Health Care Ministries Board Chairman David Whitten stated President Jack Cole is retiring. The board is now in the process of accepting applications.
