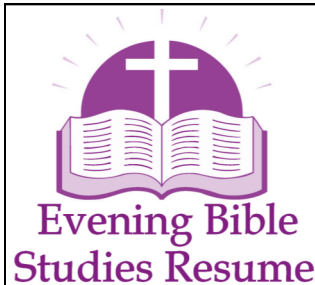


Our church website has NEW Pages for our

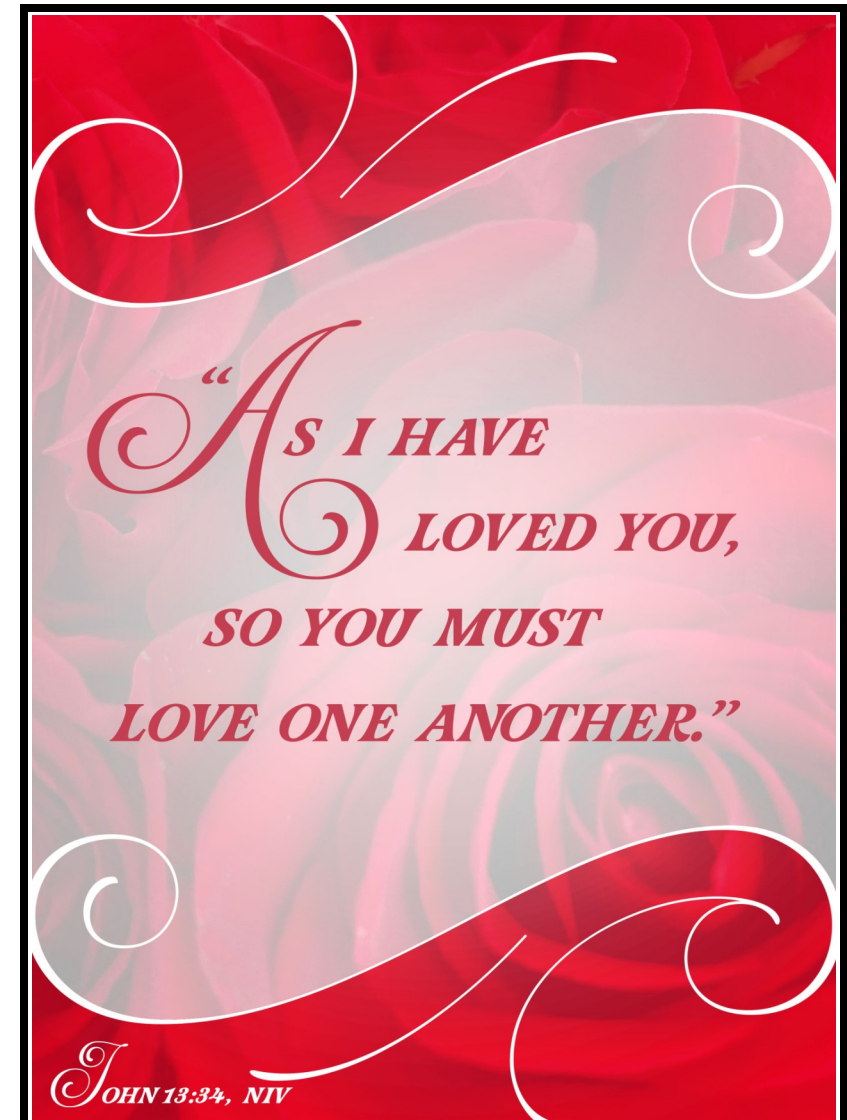
