


Online giving is a great way to support your church when you cannot be here. We currently use Tithe-ly for our online giving, and we will continue to. Just click the \$ sign on our webpage at

You may drop your items off in the clear bin in the sanctuary.




The church office will be closed Friday, July 3rd in observance
