## From the Desk of Les the Mess:

Here we are starting October, can you believe it? Again, this year, and it hasn't been quite a year, seems like it has been 3 years long! I don't want another election year to be this contentious, this has been awful! But prayerfully, this will be all over after November the 3<sup>rd</sup>. I would love the churches to be back open fully after that and we can gather to worship and fellowship without "big brother" government looking over our shoulder.

We have some exciting times approaching in the life of our church. First, on October 25, we will be celebrating with Doyle Chambers and his family. Doyle has been a Deacon at First Baptist Church for 38 years. Actually, his ordination date was October 24, 1982. So, it seems fitting to honor him for his service to the Lord and our church. At the request of Doyle and recommendation of the Deacon body, Doyle will be moving from active Deacon to Deacon Emeritus. The Deacon suggested and the church approved it at Business Meeting to call October 25, 2020, Doyle Chambers Day. Sunday morning, Nov. 4<sup>th</sup>, Brother Danny Ringer, our Director of Missions, will be here to help us kick off our Revival. Then in the evening at 6:30 pm and nightly, Bro. Marty Brock will be the evangelist. Marge Candler, his sister, will accompany him playing the piano and singing. They have been here before, but we always look forward to them coming. One thing for certain, when they come, they will be prayed up and prepared with messages and songs God will use in our lives.

Revival, for those who do not know what this is or have forgotten (because we have not had one in a long time (LOL)), is a specific set of services calling the church back to renewal. Webster's Dictionary defines revival this way, to recover from neglect. With the events of this pandemic, election year chaos, and just busyness of everyday life, it is easy to lose focus on what is vitally essential and important. It is critical for a church to get together in fellowship around the word and the Lord Jesus, which is the true Biblical definition of fellowship. Mark it on your calendar and make plans to attend this Revival.

We have set aside, as well, time to pray for an important season for our church. On the request of the Deacon body, we are asking the church to pray about the possibility of election of more Deacons. 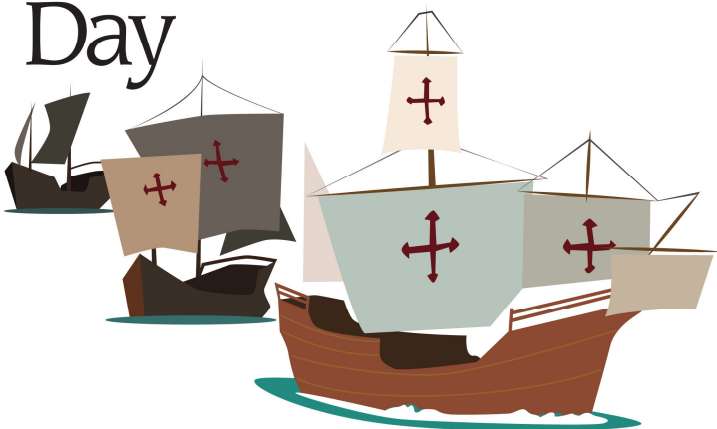

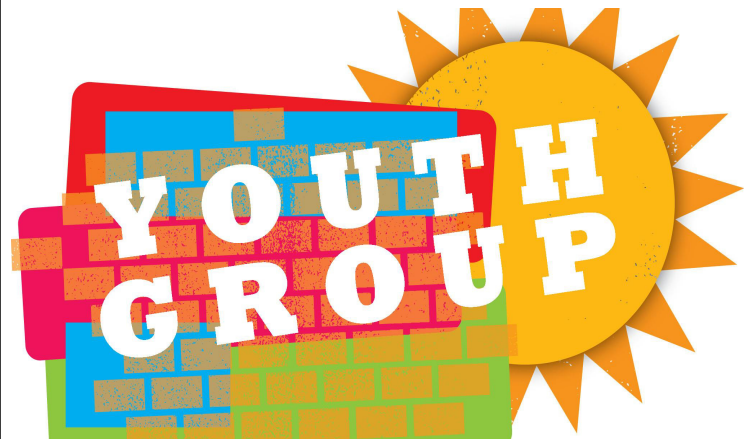
