



THE LIBERATION OF THE HEART

We were created by God and intended to have a relationship with Him. That relationship was destroyed, for death came into the world because of sin: however, through Jesus' sacrifice on the cross, our sins can be forgiven and eternal life received.

We were created with a body, soul, and spirit. Our bodies are governed by our mind. The Holy Spirit, God's gift to us, governs our heart, and the salvation of the soul is God's completed work in us. So let's begin with the human heart.

"The heart is deceitful above all things and beyond cure. Who can understand it?" (Jeremiah 17:9).

The Lord answers: "I the Lord search the heart and examine the mind, to reward a man according to his conduct, according to what his deeds deserve" (Jeremiah 17:10).

The Deeds Required

The deed the Lord requires is that we turn to Him for help. Before we were born, God sent his Son into the world to make redemption for the human race possible.

Jesus said: "Come to me all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest" (Matthew 11:28).

When we pray for salvation, God performs a supernatural transforming work in us:

"I will give you a new heart and put a new spirit in you; "I will remove from you your heart of stone and give you a heart of flesh" (Ezekiel 36:26).

Salvation Begins in the Heart: "Having believed, you were marked in him with a seal, the promised, Holy Spirit, who is a deposit guaranteeing our inheritance" (Ephesians 1:13).

Salvation is of God: "Now it is God who makes both us and you stand firm in Christ. He anointed us, set his seal of ownership on us, and put his Spirit in our hearts as a deposit" (II Corinthians 1:21).

It involves Confession: "He who confesses me before men, him will I confess before my Father in heaven. But who denies me before men, him I will also deny before my Father in heaven" (Matthew 10:32 (KJV).

It is Conditional: "Not everyone who says to me, Lord, Lord, will enter the kingdom of heaven, but only he who does the will of my Father who is in heaven" (Matthew 7:21).

It is Fragile: "Guard the good deposit that was entrusted to you—guard it with the help of the Holy Spirit who lives in us" (II Timothy 1:14).

It Requires Maintenance: "Continue to work out your salvation with fear and trembling" (Philippians 2:12).

It asks for Endurance: "But we are not of those who shrink back and are destroyed, but of those who believe and are saved" (Hebrews 10:39).

Salvation Is Evidenced:

Yes, salvation begins with God's Spirit giving us a consciousness of sin, requesting that we come to Him for forgiveness. Upon this request, we receive his Spirit in our heart. With the Spirit's help, we begin our spiritual journey of love and obedience to what Jesus taught.

"Whoever has my commands and obey them, he is the one who loves me. He who loves me will be loved by my Father and I too will love him and show myself to him" (John 14:21).

No Greater Love...

"Love one another as I have loved you, so you must love one another" (John 15:12). "Greater love has no one than this that he lay down his life for his friends. You are my friends if you do what I command" (John 15:13,14).

So dear friends,

"Let us love one another, for love comes from God. Everyone who loves has been born of God and knows God. Whoever does not love does not know God, because God is love" (I John 4:7-8).
