Thirty some years ago when Hal Lindsay's book, *The Late Great Planet Earth*, first appeared in the Christian book stores we read with interest and a certain amount of unease of an approaching day when a One World Order would engulf our lives and rob us of the freedoms we enjoy as Americans. An event occurred several years ago in California that reminded me that the One World Order may not be just another farfetched conspiracy theory but possibly a present day calculated social reconstruction of our culture. The event I'm referring to happened to a Christian young man in California. Here's a synopsis of the story as told by reporters Charlie Butts and Jody Brown of *OneNewsNow.Com*.

"After being called a "fascist" by his professor, one California student, a Christian, has filed suit against his college for violations of his free-speech rights. Less than a month after voters in California decided to amend their state constitution and protect traditional marriage, Jonathan Lopez -- in a public speaking class -- shared his beliefs on faith and marriage. David French of the Alliance Defense Fund picks up the story. 'Jonathan talked about his faith -- and one of the things he talked about in context of his faith was...marriage, says French. "He read from the dictionary definition of marriage. The professor stopped the class, called him a 'fascist ______-- [he] used the expletive -- [and] told the class that anyone who wanted to could leave if they were offended....'. According to an ADF press release, when no one got up to leave, the instructor simply dismissed the class, effectively ending Lopez's speech -- which violated the student's free-speech rights, adds the attorney, especially since other students made speeches on other subjects. Religious speech, notes French, apparently was excluded from the open-ended speech assignment."

Religious discrimination is certainly not new to Christian America. The Apostle Paul wrote to Timothy, "Yes, and all who desire to live godly in Christ Jesus will suffer persecution. But evil men and imposters will grow worse and worse, deceiving and being deceived. But you must continue in the things which you have learned and been assured of, knowing from whom you have learned them, and that from childhood you have known the Holy Scriptures, which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus." (2nd Timothy 3:12-15).

Our privilege as Followers of Jesus Christ is to continue in the faith, encouraging one another as we do so, in spite of any persecution we may encounter along the way.
