

Dear Church Family,

God has given us great opportunities to serve and I want to thank all of you who have been serving. May I take a moment to brag on what God is doing in and through you? We have witnessed people of various ages choosing to follow Christ. There has been 17 baptisms since October and a total of 26 new members. Thank you Bethel family for being a part of that and making connections. You have also went out into our community and made meaningful connections through our school adoption and community appreciation projects. You continue to support the food pantry ministry which meets a lot of needs in Salem weekly. AWANA had a great year, the weekday preschool has ministered to 60 plus preschool children, our WE JAM ministry has ministered to 25-40 preschool children weekly, our children's Sunday morning connect groups and children's church ministers to 25 and at times 40 kids on any given Sunday. The After School program has ministered to kids from six different elementary schools. Right now our summer program is housing about 84 elementary school aged kids. We recently had some of our after school kids profess Christ as their Lord. Under the guidance of Debbie Holly, we were able to start a tutoring program for struggling kids. Our teen ministry is growing and God is doing great things under the present leadership. Josh and Kelly have also started a college and career connect group that meets bi-weekly. Last night one of our college students were baptized at the beach. I am proud of all our adult connect groups that do ministry together as well as dive deeper into the Word of God. Now we really need more groups as we estimate about 150 people that are not connected weekly. We are not looking for ability as much as availability of potential group leaders. You may be surprised at what God can do through you.

Let me also take a moment to share some challenges we are facing. We need additional funding for a children's director. I am really not sure where it will come from, but God knows. For quite some time now we have needed this, but we have no financial resources to support that staffing position. The leadership in all of our children's ministries are great, but we need that one person to oversee it and guide it along the way. We want to make sure that our children's ministries are thriving and moving in the right direction. So I am praying that we can invest more into our children's ministries in the near future.

Another concern is the limited funding for outreach and evange-lism projects. Now that we are immersed into adopting a local school, hosting "5<sup>th</sup> Quarters" in the Fall, and doing other community events we need more financial support. As we pray for provision, let's keep serving and discovering ways in which we can reach our culture with the gospel.
