Dear Legacy Family,

A few decades ago, I began to verbalize the principle, *"We do not choose our circumstances, but we do choose where we will dwell in the midst of them."* This statement is a fitting reminder, as we face every new crisis. It is a grace•faith truism that becomes an effective perspective changer.

This became an apparent truth while preparing for an elementary chapel service. The focus was on Psalm 91:1, where the names of God naturally captivate our attention. *"He who dwells in the shelter of the Most High will abide in the shadow of the Almighty."*

"El Elyon," the Hebrew/English transliteration for "the Most High," proclaims that *God alone sovereignly reigns over all things.*

"El Shaddai" is the transliteration for "the Almighty" declaring that Almighty God *enables us to join Him while He accomplishes everything He has promised and purposed.*

Truly, there is no better place for us to dwell during this pandemic than in the shelter of the Most High.

As Legacy's administration team attempts to make wise decisions, we struggle with our inability to create the perfect plan.
