## **Tom's Thoughts**

We are nearly at the end of another year. Each year ends with an incredible story. From a human perspective, it is an unbelievable story. It is a story of a young woman who was a virgin, and yet she was with child. She became the talk of her little town, and the embarrassment of her soon to be husband. It is said this is the greatest story ever. However her story, like all of ours, is defined by our life story. This young woman's story changed her life. Her life story can change the story of others. So important was her life story that it is found in God's word, the Bible. Her life story began with a visit by an angel. She was asked by the angel if she would yield her life for God's divine purpose. She said, "Yes." Nine months later the young woman, with her husband by her side, gave birth to a baby boy. The birth was normal, or was it? Something unbelievable happened that night. Her life story and the birth of her son was as Luke wrote, v.2:11 '...today in the city of David there has been born for you a Savior, who is Christ the Lord.' Her life story was centered around the baby who was God. For He had come down from heaven to be born as a baby through this young virgin with God as His Father. With His birth, His life story continued as part of His eternal existence.

His story changed her life forever, and her baby would have an impact on others, causing the change in their lives as well. There were a group of shepherds. That night they had been caring for their sheep, when they were also visited by angels. They were directed to where the mother and child could be found. When they came to the stable, they found the scene just as they had been told. Luke wrote of their response, v.2:17 'When they had seen this, they made known the statement which had been told them about this Child.' Their story was changed and they wanted to tell others about what they had seen. There were others who came into contact with this mother and baby in the days that followed, and like Mary, her husband, and the shepherds their stories would also be forever changed.

About twenty years ago, NAMB produced a tract, 'Your Story...

How Will It Turn Out.' Personally I believe it was one of the best, however sadly it is now out of print. We find inside of the tract a great truth, 'God is interested in your life story.' There are three elements to this truth; 'God knows you, God loves you, and God has a plan for your life.' Then we read how, 'We attempt to write our own story,' however we are not able to change our story to a forever life story. The truth is that only, 'Jesus Christ can change our life story forever for us.' As we read in the tract the truth is, 'Jesus wants to be the Author of the change of our life story.'
