May we continue on the path that God has for each of us.

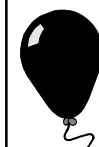

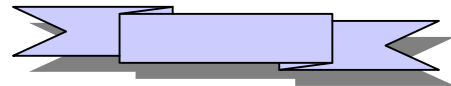
### UPCOMING EVENTS
