Anniversaries. Cumberland Presbyterian Church in Lubbock has celebrated several recently: In February of this year, the 200-year anniversary of the birth of this denomination; in May, 48 years since Pastor Emeritus Sam Estes' first sermon at this church; also in May, 40 years since the tornado destroyed the building on Tenth and Avenue O; and only two years back, the 100th anniversary of the establishment of this congregation in Lubbock.

There are also Biblical anniversaries: Passover to celebrate the miraculous delivery from Egyptian slavery; Pentecost to celebrate both the blessing of a new harvest and the beginning of Spirit-empowered ministry among Christians; Resurrection Sunday to celebrate the fact that Jesus has power over all sin and death!

BEREAVEMENT MEALS

June 2010

CPC wishes to take this opportunity to thank each and every one of you who have so graciously and willingly given of your time, talent and resources to this program of serving meals for the families of deceased members.

This service began December 2000, with two separate groups serving meals. We do not have the man power to have two groups at this time, so we are down-sizing to a single group. We **love** doing this! It is **rewarding** but **WE NEED HELP!**

Serving a meal to the family of a deceased member involves:

- Coordinating the meal by calling 12-15 people to prepare an assigned dish.
- Two hours of setting up Estes Center prior to the meal (cleaning and setting tables, and usually done the day before).

Ordering chicken the day before the meal.

On the day of the service:

- At least 4-6 people arrive around 10:00 a.m. to make tea and coffee, receive the prepared dishes as they arrive and set up the steam table. Dessert and Jello salads are placed on individual plates. Glasses are filled with ice for tea and water. Those that set up also bring one of the prepared dishes.
- Pick up the chicken 30 minutes before meal is served.
- Serve the dinner.

Clean up after the meal.

Often times these four to six people are at the Estes Center from 10:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m.

We serve a planned menu; each one who prepares a dish uses the same furnished recipe each time a meal is served. Casserole containers are furnished that will fit in the steam table. Only one person is needed to bring bread, so you may be asked to bring any one of the dishes listed below.
