Spotting Someone Who's Lost Ephesians 2:1-7

Three parables in Luke 15 The Lost Sheep The Lost Coin The Lost (prodigal) son **Explain Jesus' concern for "sinners"**



Who is Jesus calling lost? Not healthy; but sick Not righteous; but sinners Those who are blind (can't see or won't see)



Spotting Someone Who's Lost Ephesians 2:1-7

Who is Jesus calling lost? Not healthy; but sick Not righteous; but sinners "Jesus came not to condemn but to save" John 3:17



Lost" is not a word of condemnation; our purpose of identifying the condition of "lost-ness" is not to judge but to rescue



Spotting Someone Who's Lost Ephesians 2:1

Paul describes a lost person as "dead in our trespasses and sins."











Deadness can be caused by "walking according to the course of this world..."





Spotting Someone Who's Lost Ephesians 2:2

Humanism: a system of thought attaching prime importance to human rather than divine. **Humanists seek solely rational** ways of solving human problems.



"There is no God..." "God" is a crutch." "The Bible is merely myths" "There is no absolute right or wrong"



Spotting Someone Who's Lost Ephesians 2:2

Deadness can be caused by "walking according to prince of the power of the air" ("god of this world," "prince of this age"



Deceived by Satan: This person believes in God, but also believes the lies that Satan has propagated about God.





Spotting Someone Who's Lost Ephesians 2:2

"There's many ways to God" "I've been good; I'll be OK" "I trust the man upstairs." "A God of love won't send people to Hell"



"The lack of love for the lost is the backbone of the religious spirit..." Ed Silvoso, author of Than None Should Perish



Spotting Someone Who's Lost Ephesians 2:3

Deadness can be caused by "living in the lust and desire of the flesh and mind"





Because we think we see (know), we are blind (ignorant): Example: Jesus statement who all who witnessed a healing, yet denied it.



Spotting Someone Who's Lost Ephesians 2:3

'God doesn't heal anymore' "God helps those who help themselves" "God gave this to enjoy" "I'm too bad to be loved



But God...rich in mercy...because of His great love...even when we were dead...made us alive with Christ!
